NOTIFICATION: B.ED ENTRANCE TEST-2016

It is notified for all concerned that there will be an entrance test for admission in to the B.ED course in the B.ED colleges affiliated to Gauhati University and recognized by the NCTE. The said examination will be held on **21-07-2016**. The proposed examination will be held as per the following guideline.

1. The entrance will be **centrally conducted** by the Gauhati University **for all the colleges recognised by the NCTE and affiliated to Gauhati University**.
2. Filling up of **application forms** for the entrance, **issue of challan** for the deposit of the entrance fee and **issue of admit cards** will be carried out in the **online mode only**. As such hardcopy application form will not be received.
3. The form will be online on **23-06-2016 after 5 p.m.**
4. The entrance test will be of **100 marks** of **two and half hours** duration.
5. The breakup of the 100 marks will be like this-
 - a. General English 20 marks
(Vocabulary, Tense, Voice, Narration, Prepositions
Correction of sentences)
 - b. General Knowledge 20 marks
(Indian History, Indian Polity, General Science,
Current affairs)
 - c. Numerical aptitude and mental ability 15 marks
 - d. Teaching aptitude 20 marks
(Concept, Nature and Characteristics of teaching,
Teaching Learning Process
Role and responsibilities of a teacher
Teaching skills and teaching effectiveness
Teaching aids
Evaluation system)
 - e. Current Indian Education 25 marks
(Issues and Policies)
National Policy on Education 1986
Universalization of elementary education –
Right to Education, Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA)
Secondary education – Rastriya Madhyamik
Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), Vocationalization
of secondary education, Operation Blackboard,

6. All questions will be compulsory and will be of MCQ type with four alternative choices of which only one answer will be the correct option.
7. The **test Booklet** and the **OMR** will be in **English**.
8. Proper weightage will be given to marks secured in the qualifying examination.
Example- if a student secured 76% in the qualifying examination and 55% in the entrance test, the total score will be $7.6+5.5=13.1$
9. There will be no negative marks for wrong answers.
10. The test will be **OMR based**.
11. Eligibility-as per NCTE norms
12. Choice of centre of the Entrance Test will be available in the online form.
13. Reservation and relaxation policy will be as per existing G.U. rules.
14. Interested students are instructed visit the Gauhati University website- ***www.gauhati.ac.in*** from time to time for updates in relation to this test.
15. Anything not covered by this guideline will be decided by the university authority at appropriate level.
16. Application and Entrance Examination Fee Rs. 600/-
(Bank charges extra to be borne by the applicant)
17. Last date of submission of form : **11-07-2016**
18. Last date of payment of fee : **13-07-2016**
