



**ELECTION OF THE POST-GRADUATE STUDENTS' UNION OF GAUHATI UNIVERSITY FOR THE SESSION 2019-20**

It is notified for information of all the students of the Post-Graduate Classes of Gauhati University that the election to the different offices of the Post-Graduate Students' Union for the session 2019-20 will be held by Secret Ballot as per order of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor G.U.

The Election will be conducted in a manner that conforms to the standards prescribed in the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India as communicated vide No. PC/HE/CC.13/2006/16 dated 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 from the Director of Higher Education, Assam.

In pursuance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's directives all the regular full time P.G. 1<sup>st</sup>& 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester, LLM 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester and 7<sup>th</sup>& 9<sup>th</sup> Semester Integrated Commerce students of University Classes, G.U. for the session 2019-20 are eligible for contesting as well as voting in the election. Further, the Post-Graduate Students' Union, G.U. shall comprise only of regular full time students on the Rolls of the University Classes, Gauhati University.

**Prof. Dwipen Bezbaruah Dept. of Anthropology, Gauhati University** is appointed as the Returning Officer of the said Election. He will be assisted by the following Election Officers: 1. **ELECTION RULES**

The following ELECTION RULES have been framed in a manner in conformity with the prescribed directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India as communicated vide no. PC/HE/CC.13/2006/16 dated 18.11.06 from the Director of Higher Education, Assam, for fair and smooth conduct of G.U. Post-Graduate Students' Union Election 2019-20 held in 2019.

1. All the regular full time PG/7<sup>th</sup>& 9<sup>th</sup> Semester Integrated Commerce students of University Classes, G.U. for the session 2019-20 are eligible for contesting as well as voting in the election.  
Students from whom Union Fee is not chargeable are not eligible to contest in the election as well as is not eligible to cast his/her vote. No exemption from this rule can be made, even in the case of scholarship holders.
2. The student willing to contest in the election should have **minimum 75% attendance in the classes.**  
(to be certified by the Head of the Department in the Nomination Paper).
3. The maximum upper age limit of a candidate shall be **25 years** on the date of Election (casting of vote).
4. The candidate shall not have any academic arrear (i.e. absent in whole examination, arrear in any paper/subject in the earlier Semesters/Part of the present course).
5. The candidate shall not have any previous criminal record, that is, he/she should not have been tried and/ or convicted of any criminal offense. The candidate must not have any record of disciplinary action taken by the University. The candidates shall declare that he/she has no criminal records in the past.
6. A candidate will be allowed to contest for one office only.
7. The Voter/Candidate including his/her agent must produce his/her valid **Identity Card** before the Polling Officers at the time of receiving Ballot Paper and also whenever required.
8. Candidate and his/her agent (only one agent) may be present in the Election premises during the Polling hours with the permission of the Returning Officer. Any other person will not be allowed to enter the Election premises without prior permission from the Returning Officer except already authorized for Election duties.
9. Display of Posters and Wall Writings on the walls of the University Buildings, University Halls, Canteens and Roadside Walls of G.U. Campus are strictly prohibited.
10. No Office or any display will be allowed within the area demarcated for the Election purpose.
11. No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students. Further no 'corrupt practices' such as intimidation of voters, including any violent activities, bringing voters, impersonation etc. are strictly prohibited.
12. No Election canvassing activity whatsoever of a candidate will be allowed within the Election premises.
13. The maximum permitted election related expenditure per candidate shall be Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five thousand) only.
14. Any Election canvassing activity must not in any manner disturb the Classes and other activities of the University. **As such, there shall not be any campaigning inside the class rooms.**
15. Election Canvass:
  - (a) **Date** : From 5.00 p.m. on 19.09.2019 to 10.00 a.m. on 23.09.2019
  - (b) **Open Debate at BKB Auditorium** : **20.09.2019 from 11.00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.**  
**and 2:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.**
  - (c) There will be no camping in the Girls Halls campus beyond normal entry time.

The above rules will be enforced strictly and non adherence of these directives will be considered as violation of election code.

16. Rules and schedule for Open Debate will be published on **19-09-2019**.

All canvassing must stop 24 hours before the commencement of the poll, i.e. by **10:00 a.m. on 23-09-2019**

17. Any infringement of the above mentioned rules will be subject to penalties, which may include disqualification of the candidature, cancellation of voting right and disciplinary action.
18. The procedure for voting is as follows:

Voters shall cast their votes from **9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on 24.09.2019**. Cross mark (X) to be put in the box using the stamp against the name of the desired candidates without touching the boarder lines as shown below:
