# Request for Proposal (RFP) for Group Health Insurance (GHI) – 2024-25 for Employees (Including dependents) of Gauhati University

Gauhati University Teachers Association (here in after referred to as GUTA) invites insurance companies currently registered with IRDA to offer GHI for coverage of current employees (including dependents) of Gauhati University. However they can continue to be covered under GHI after their retirement from the university. The RFP is for a period of one (1) year under Two Bid System (Bid-1 Technical & Bid-2 Financial)

Hard copy of the quotation addressed to The Gauhati University Teachers Association (GUTA), Faculty House, (Near Department of Business Administration), Jalukbari, Guwahati-781014 should reach on or before 31st October 2024.

#### Main feature of the GHI-2024-25.

i. Cover of treatment.

Each employee irrespective of the age group will be entitled to family floater sum insured.

Quotes to be given for (A) Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs. Two lakhs only) and (B) Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rs. Five lakh only) **Separately.** 

Additionally, corporate Floater (buffer) sum Insured of Rs. 50,00,000 (Rs. fifty lakhs only) to be utilized at the discretion and approval of the competent authority of Gauhati University (GU) for utilization by existing employees and their eligible dependents only.

The family of existing employees means and includes dependent spouse, dependent sons, dependent daughters (including unmarried daughters), and dependent parents.

- ii. Existing family floater cover shall continue for residual family member of employee dying in harness till expiry of the policy.
- iii. (a) Pre-existing diseases/ailments, waiting period and excluded diseases are to be covered under the policy without any medical test for all employees including new additions during the currency of the policy.
- b) The policy shall cover all types of hospitalization expenses anywhere in India without any co-payment clause.

iv. Full details of the terms of insurance coverage has been stated in the Techno Commercial Bid enclosed herewith and marked **Annexure-A**.

v. 'Day Care' facilities (where treatment in Hospital / Nursing Home takes less than 24 hours

and the patient is released on the same day) to be covered shall be as per list attached in **Annexure-C**. However, the list of 'Day-Care' facilities as attached in annexure C is not exhaustive. The technical bid should contain the list of day care facilities (if any) to be covered by the insurance company for inclusion under GHIS in addition to the list included in Annexure C.

vi. The data showing demography of the population of existing employees to be covered (including dependents) under GHI for respective age group & family size is detailed as **Annexure E**. This data is indicative with regard to the group size. The final group size will vary from what is stated in Annexure E.

vii. A list of Critical illness/surgeries to be covered is as per list attached in **Annexure-G**. These critical illnesses shall be eligible for coverage under corporate buffer after the SI in the family floater is exhausted by the employee. However, the list of 'Critical illness/surgeries' as attached is not exhaustive. The technical bid should contain the list of critical illnesses (if any) to be covered by the insurance company for inclusion under GHIS in addition to the list included in Annexure G.

viii. The maximum age of entry for any family members and the premium as per demography detail of Annexure- E.

#### Techno-Commercial bid:

a) The terms of the bid are enumerated at **Annexure-A** in a separate envelope suitably marked. The bidders have to categorically confirm that their quotation covers to each and every point (Sl. No.1 to Sl. No.8) of enclosed

techno commercial bid without any deviation/alteration and/or change and/or modification. The bidders must confirm that they fully accept the terms and conditions stated in the Technocommercial Bid. This would be signed by authorized signatory of the bidder.

b)) Any deviation / alteration and or changes of the said terms & conditions of the Techno Commercial Bid would render the quotation of bidders invalid and GUTA reserves the right to reject any defective offer/counter offer without assigning any reasons.

#### Price bid (Annexure-B):

The price bid **Annexure-B** shall be submitted as per the listed format in a separate envelope suitably marked.

The price should not be indicated in ANNEXURES (A to H) enclosed, otherwise the bid will be liable to be rejected.

Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC) for the Insurance Companies who are eligible for bidding.

- 1. The insurance company should be registered with IRDA for at least five years (proof to be attached).
- 2. The Insurance Company must have been in operation in Indian market in the field of Medical & Health Insurance for a period of at least five years as on tender opening date. Last five years IRDA payment (Financial Years) receipt is to be attached in support of fulfilling this criterion.
- 3. The Insurance Company is presently handling at least two clients in the Central /State Public Sector Undertaking or/and Central/ State Government or/and state/central university in the area of Group / Group Floater Medical Insurance. Copies of work order/ proof of payment of premium/ Insurance policy issued is to be attached in support of fulfilling this criterion.
- 4. Insurance company should offer cashless facility. The list of hospitals/ Nursing homes where the cashless facility shall be available should be enclosed with the techno commercial bid. In case treatment is obtained from a hospital/nursing home other than where cashless facility is available, then the modality of settlement of claim should be clearly indicated.
- 5. The Insurance Company should have an office in Guwahati. Tax copy of Guwahati Municipal Corporation or Electricity bill is to be attached in support of fulfilling this criterion.
- 6. The insurance company should be depute an official of the company (official directly employed by the insurance company not any contractual staff or agent etc.) to be physically present in the university on at least once a week. On each of these days, the official should be physically present in GUTA office for at least two hours during office hours of Gauhati University. This official shall facilitate submission of claims and provide all other services to make operation of GHI smooth. In addition, the insurance company should agree to provide a single point of contact with telephone number and email for smooth operation of the GHI.

#### Bidders may also please note the following:

Techno Commercial Bid (Annexure-A) is to be submitted along with the following documents

- a) A copy of tender document duly signed and stamped on each page as a token of acceptance of all terms and conditions in affirmative.
- b) Documentary evidence of proof of fulfilling Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC) as desired for this RFP
- c) The bidders should accept the **Annexure-C** being the 'List of Day-Care facilities' duly signed by authorized signatories with seal.
- d) The bidders should accept the **Annexure-D** containing Other Terms & Conditions duly signed by authorized signatories with seal.
- e) The bidders have to submit a Bid Security Declaration as per Annexure-H of GU

Price Bid (Annexure-B) has to be quoted as per prescribed format. The price bid should not be indicated in Part-I bid otherwise the bid will be liable to be rejected.

The offer shall remain valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of the bid. GU reserves its right to reject any offer either in full or in part at its own discretion.

The last date for submission of offer/quotation is 31.10.2024.

Please note that only one bid shall be acceptable from one bidding insurance company. If two or more bids are submitted, the last one shall be considered final.
