


4-Day International Youth Leadership Development Program (The Fundamentals of Leadership)



The Zoological Society of Assam (ZSA), Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC), Darrang College and ZSA Unit, Darrang College, Tezpur organized a webinar on "Strategy for Cracking NEET (UG Medical Entrance Exam)" on 31st August, 2020 targeting the ensuing NEET aspirants of Assam and it's neighbouring states. A renowned biologist and Academician of India, popular Academic Counsellor, Retired Prof. of Cotton University, Assam, Dr. Ratul Ch. Rajkhowa presented the most important tactics for cracking NEET in the webinar. Dr. Rajkhowa in his one and half hour-long presentation and interaction with the participant students from different educational institutions stressed on the development of basic concept and exhaustive knowledge of the HS text books of each subject for cracking NEET, a national level exam. In his interactive session, steered with Dr. Phatic Tamuli, IQAC coordinator of Darrang College Tezpur delineated some rudimentary aids for scoring marks in the entrance examination. He said "It is essential that each of the NEET aspirants must be mentally strong with exceptional personality having clear concept of each of the topics of their allotted textbooks in Higher Secondary level." He denied any crucial role of Reference Books and Coaching institutions available in the educational market now a days. The webinar was inaugurated by Dr. Joysankar Hazarika, Principal of Darrang College, Tezpur. In
