

Report of Anti-Ragging Committee, G.U. pertaining to Anti-Ragging

Case Ref. no. ARCC/AS-6919, ARCC/AS-6928, and ARCC/AS-6937

A meeting of the Gauhati University Anti -Ragging Committee was held on 21/12/2021 to discuss the complaints related to all the three aforesaid cases as the cases are confined to the same hostel (AT-9 Boys Hostel). On receipt of the complaints, the following actions were taken:

1. Explanation letters were issued on 01/11/2021 to all the identified and alleged culprits namely- Devashish Das, Anuj Pratim Bora, Iannoy Kazi, Biman Haloi, Raktim Ranjan Bora, Ranjan Bhuyan, Saurav Gogoi, Tanveer kamal Choudhary, Kangkan Medhi, Nayan Sarania, Hridoy Baruah. All the students are found to be staying in the same hostel except Anuj Pratim Bora and Biman Haloi.
2. After receiving the explanations from the concerned students a meeting of the Gauhati University Anti -Ragging Committee was held on 08/12/2021.
3. The explanations submitted by the accused students/ boarders related to aforesaid cases were read out in the meeting and discussed the same.
4. The statements given by the accused students/ boarders as well as by one identified victim (Nihar Swargiary) were recorded by videography as well as in writing.
5. The parents of the accused students/ boarders as well as the identified victim, Nihar Swargiary were called to appear in the next Anti -Ragging Committee meeting to be held on 21.12.2021 to verify the claims and facts as submitted.
6. The next meeting of the Gauhati University Anti -Ragging Committee was held on 21/12/2021.
7. The said students along with their parents appeared before the committee and presented their views regarding the alleged incident. The entire proceeding was video-recorded and written statements were also obtained from them regarding the matter. Declarations were obtained to the effect that they had no objection for recording of the statements.
8. Members of the committee reviewed the complaints, heard from all alleged students as well as their parents/guardians, and reviewed all relevant documents (all the documents mentioned above as Annexure.....). They also interacted with the concerned Warden to take stock of the investigation process and measures taken up in view of the complaints lodged.

A meeting of the Gauhati University Anti -Ragging Committee was held on 21/12/2021 to discuss the complaints related to all the three aforesaid cases as the cases are confined to the same hostel (AT-9 Boys' Hostel). On receipt of the complaints, the following actions were taken:

1. Explanation letters were issued to all the alleged accused namely- Devashish Das, Anuj Pratim Bora, Tanmoy Kazi, Biman Haloi, Raktim Ranjan Bora, Ranjan Bhuyan, Saurav Gogoi, Tanveer kamal Choudhary, Kangkan Medhi, Nayan Sarania, Hridoy Baruah. All the students are found to be staying in the same hostel except Anuj Pratim Bora and Biman Haloi.
2. After receiving the explanations from the concerned students a meeting of the Gauhati University Anti -Ragging Committee was held on 08/12/2021.
3. The explanations submitted by the alleged accused students/ boarders related to aforesaid cases were read out in the meeting and discussed the same.
4. The statements given by the alleged accused students/ boarders as well as by identified victim (Nihar Swargiary, Hridoy Barua, Ranjan Bhuyan) were recorded by videography as well as in writing.
5. The parents of the alleged accused students/ boarders as well as by three identified assumed victims, Nihar Swargiary, Hridoy Barua, Ranjan Bhuyan were called to appear in the next Anti -Ragging Committee meeting held on 21.12.2021 to verify the claims and facts as submitted.
6. The adjourned meeting of the Gauhati University Anti -Ragging Committee was held on 21/12/2021.
7. The said students along with their parents appeared before the committee and presented their views regarding the alleged incident. The entire proceeding was video-recorded and written statements were also obtained from them regarding the matter. Declarations were obtained to the effect that they had no objection for recording of the statements.
8. Members of the committee reviewed the complaints, heard from all alleged students as well as their parents/guardians, and reviewed all relevant documents and the statements (A-I, A-II, A-III & A-IV). They also interacted with the concerned Warden to take stock of the investigation process and measures taken up in view of the complaints lodged.

Report of Anti-Ragging Committee, G.U. pertaining to Anti-Ragging

Ref Nos. ARCC/AS-6840

One complaint of ragging was registered by a student pursuing Post Graduate 2nd Year of the Gauhati University with the Anti-Ragging and Anti-Racial Abuse Helpline in New Delhi on 24th October, 2021. The complaint was submitted without disclosing the name of the complainant which states about the mental harassment received from the batch mates. The student lodged the complaint against batch mates named as Ikumani Rabha, Disha Sharma, Queeny Dutta. According to the victim, the culprits abused the victim regularly, passing nonsense comments, forced her to wake up early morning and late night too and other unnecessary things for unwanted reason in Pratima Pandey Hostel. On receipt of the complaints, the following actions were taken:

1. Show-Cause notices were served on 01/11/2021 to all the identified and alleged culprits namely- Ikumani Rabha, Disha Sharma and Queeny Dutta. All these students are found to be staying in RCC-6 Girls' Hostel (Pratima Pandey Baruah Hostel), G.U.
2. Copies of these notices were also sent to the Warden of the Hostel, respective Heads of the Departments and to all the parents of the alleged students.
3. The Warden of RCC-6 Girls' Hall was requested to conduct a preliminary investigation and submit a report on the reported incident. She inquired about the matter and asked the alleged students about the matter. As reported, no one of the alleged students opined that any such incident took place as alleged. In fact, they expressed surprise at the matter.
4. The students alleged have replied to the show-cause notices (Annexure I, II, III) on time stipulated.

The Anti-Ragging Committee Meeting:

5. The Anti-Ragging Committee meeting was held from 11 a.m. on 15/11/2021. All the students alleged were asked to appear through proper communication which was also sent to the respective Heads of the Departments and the Warden concerned. The committee formally heard them in the referred meeting. It is also mentioned here that the entire proceeding was video-recorded and written statements were also obtained from them regarding the matter. Declarations were obtained to the effect that they had no objection for recording of the statements. (Annexure IV, V,VI)
6. The members of the committee studied the registered complaint, heard all the alleged students and went through all relevant papers (all the documents mentioned above as Annexure). They also interacted with the concerned Warden. They took stock of the investigation process and measures taken up in view of the complaints lodged.
7. An appraisal report of the preliminary discussion and questioning with the aforementioned students was forwarded to the Anti-Ragging and Anti-Racial Abuse Helpline on 15/11/2021.
8. A 2nd meeting of the aforesaid committee was convened on 17th November, 2021 at 3 p.m. to hear the views of the newly admitted 9 boarders including the one who has recently vacated the hostel. A formal communication in this regard was made to the warden.
9. The said students appeared before the committee and presented their views regarding the alleged incident. The entire proceeding was video-recorded and written statements were also obtained from them regarding the matter. Declarations were obtained to the effect that they had no objection for recording of the statements. (Annexure VII,VIII,IX,X,XI,XII,XIII,XIV, XV, XVI, XVII, XVIII, XIX, XX, XXI, XXII, XXIII, XXIV)

Observations:

10. After recording the statements and considering the parameter of complaints, it is found that the complaint is contrary to the statements adduced by the boarders of the concerned girl's hostel and therefore, the complaint could not be substantiated.
11. Additionally, if in future, there is a similar nature of case against the same boarders, this case will be re-opened.

Report of Residence Health & Disciplinary Board Meeting held on 03/03/2021

Venue: Meeting Room, Office of the Secretary, University Classes, G.U.
Time: 11:30 a.m.

The following members of the board namely

are present today and after threadbare discussion having taken stock of the complaint by the boarders of the Babu Jagjivan Ram Research Scholars Boys' Hostel. The Committee held a total of 4 sittings. After showing cause to five students listed in the complaint, the committee heard the complainants, the students who were show caused, one of the umpires conducting the cricket match as well as the prefects/representatives of 12 hostels who appeared before the committee. The opposite parties, namely the 5 students denied their involvement in this incident.

The members, after going through the statements observed that three students have stated in writing of having witnessed the incident wherein they stated that Anuj Protim Borah, a 3rd Semester LLB student of striking Karuna Gogoi with the cricket bat leading to instant injury resulting in his hospitalisation. The other complainants as well as the prefects/representatives who appeared before the board stated that being at a distance they could not identify the person(s) involved, though all of them heard a noise, that appeared to be a striking of the cricket bat.

The prefects/ representatives stated due to a missed-catch and instant misbehaviour altercation by the wicketkeeper to the batsman in the match that resulted in a dispute, they were asked by the organizing committee as well the umpires to resolve the matter so as to proceed with the game. They suggested that the game be resumed on the basis of a debarring the wicketkeeper and award of five runs to the AT-9 Boys' Hall team. However, the prefect/representative of AT-9 Boys' Hall namely Pradipta Talukdar refused to accept the said decision and demanded disqualification of the Babu Jagjiban Ram Hostel. Soon thereafter the field was invaded by a large number of spectators resulting in commotion and assault.

The above view regarding the altercation in the game has also been stated by Surajit Talukdar who was conducting the match at that time as the square-leg umpire.

The members have gone into all aspects and are of the unanimous view that the involvement of Sri Anuj Protim Bora in the alleged incident appears to have taken place. Hence the committee suggests that Sri Bora may be visited with disciplinary measures to the extent of debarring him for one year (two semesters of LLB course) and also be expelled from the A.T.-9 Boys' Hall.


The committee is of the view that the action of Prefect/representative of AT-9 Boys' Hall Sri Pradiptta Talukdar is also responsible for the offense of the incident and violating the decision of the Umpire. Hence, Sri Talukdar is debarred from staying in the hostel, AT-9 Boys' Hall.


As against the others, the committee has not found any adverse statement regarding their direct involvement in the incident.

In addition to the above, the members strongly feel that any tournament and event to be held in the future should be only with prior written approval from the appropriate University authority by the organising committee, which should include bonafide students, concerned warden, HOD and other teaching and administrative officials wherever applicable. . Further, it should be strictly ensured through undertakings that no outsiders/ Ex-student be permitted to take part in any event including sports, cultural and games being organised within the GU campus. Any violation would lead to disciplinary action by the University authority.






