❖ **PLANTATION DRIVE PROGRAMME ORGANISED BY GAUHATI UNIVERSITY NSS CELL DURING ENTIRE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 2021:** A month long Plantation Drive programme was organised by Gauhati University NSS Cell along with all the affiliated college NSS Units in different parts of Assam. ❖ GAUHATI UNIVERSITY CELEBRATED RIVERS OF INDIA PROGRAM AT PANDU GHAT

As a part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav Gauhati University in association with NSS Cell of the University organised a programme “Celebrating Rivers of India” at Pandu Ghat near the bank of river Brahmaputra. Under the advice of Vice-Chancellor, GU Prof. P.J.Handique and UGC & Jal Shakti Mission, Govt of India, the team led by Dr Ranjan Kr Kakati, DSW and Programme Coordinator, GU NSS cell along with Dr Rituparna Bora, NSS PO, GU campus NSS Unit.
