Surveillance and Subversion in Mary Shelley's *Frankenstein*

Edward Said in *Orientalism* argues that during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, the West visualised the Orient as a site where everything in need of correction or containment was situated, so that any image emerging from such an orientalist perspective would signify the need for surveillance, study, discipline or governing. From this standpoint, Mary Shelley's *Frankenstein* comes across as an instance of the tendency of Western Enlightenment to assimilate what it deems undesirable and/or threatening in the Orient as the Other. Such a reading becomes possible when one looks at the 'oriental' character of Safie (the Arabian) who is transformed into a liberal woman through her 'Western' education steeped in history and literature. She, being a woman, implicitly becomes the site of assimilation into the master culture. Joyce Zonana comments that writers like Mary Wollstonecraft, Elizabeth Barrett Browning and Margaret Fuller employed images of an oppressive Orient to critique patriarchal practices in their own culture, so as to engender possibilities for and to create a case for women's freedom and independence in Western culture (a process she terms "feminist orientalism"). Safie, moreover, becomes a point of contact between the Western world and the alien world of the monster through her relationship with the De Laceys and as the principal object of the monster's gaze. As she gradually acquires the language, manners, culture and history of England, the monster also begins to enter into the realm of language and culture by emulating Safie's speech and actions. However, the monster's access to Western knowledge does not give him entry into the world of the Enlightened West. Again, while Henry Clerval's interests in Oriental literature and languages is motivated by commercial aspects, *Frankenstein* is attracted more by the erotic and sexualised landscape that he imaginatively constructs out of his readings of Oriental tales in translation. All these images conjured in the novel become indicative of the way the Orient is otherised by both dominant patriarchal institutions and practices and by the emergent 19th-century feminism. However, the figure of the monster can perhaps be seen as effecting or at least attempting to effect a subtle subversion of such a discourse. My paper will attempt to read Mary Shelley's *Frankenstein* against the grain through an exploration of these issues.

Coleridge's "Clerisy" and Confucianism in "The American Scholar": How They Inspired Ralph Waldo Emerson

It is known that Emerson was an extensive reader and learned widely from authors from various countries. Among these authors, Coleridge and Confucius occupied significant places. In this paper, I would focus attention on the influence of Samuel Taylor Coleridge's idea of "clerisy" and Confucian thought on Emerson's argument on such central topics as scholars' relationship with "nature" and "past," and their "actions" — the duties they are expected to perform in society — in "The American Scholar" (1837).

Coleridge's *On the Constitution of the Church and State* (hereafter *Church and State*), *Statesman's Manual*, and *The Friends* were the books Emerson read with enthusiasm since the mid 1820s. As early as 1830, Emerson became interested in Chinese philosophy, and he read *Analects of Confucius* (1809) translated by Joshua Marshman in 1836, when he was working on the themes which would be materialized in "The American Scholar." His journals and notebook entries show that he was interested in the words of Confucius which related to human relationship including humanities (仁) and filial piety (孝), and learned men's duties in society.

I would like to show that Coleridge and Confucius are playing complementing roles each other in the mind of Emerson. In *Church and State*, Coleridge divided "clerisy" into two groups according to the — The first group consists of a smaller number of pioneering people who expand the

CREATING "A FEEL OF HOME":
AN EXPLORATION OF THE ROLE OF MIGRANT WOMEN
IN A CHANGE OF SKIES AND BONE CHINA

This paper is based on my observations on the role of women in the works of two expatriate Sri Lankan authors; namely, *A Change of Skies* by Yasmine Gooneratne and *Bone China* by Roma Tearne. I would like to consider the roles of women in expatriate settings in these works in the light of Deniz Kandiyoti's argument in "Identity and its Discontents: Women and the Nation." Her position that women, and more significantly migrant women, are expected to be the "custodians of cultural particularisms" in expatriate settings would be looked at closely in relation to the female characters in these works. I will look at the particular ways in which women strive to retain a feel of "Home," and the manner in which these attempts reflect on these women's identities. I would be employing these characters to argue that women are largely held responsible for "creating a feel of Home" in exilic conditions. While this may be seen to limit their assimilation into the host culture, I hope to maintain that they are often the key to creating cross cultural links with the host culture/other culture.

INDIAN ENGLISH POETRY

Dolikajyoti Sharma

In their account of India's ecological history, *This Fissured Land: An Ecological History of India*, Madhav Gadgil and Ramachandra Guha trace the transformation of the nation from its pre-modern past through its colonial and postcolonial history to its contemporary mosaic of development and poverty, conservation and misuse of natural resources. The ideals of freedom and prosperity in post-independence India have given way to poverty, corruption and bureaucratic indifference. Given such a context, it is interesting to look at how contemporary Indian poetry in English has responded to the ecological aspect of envisioning the Indian nation. Taking off from these issues, this paper attempts to locate the idea of India in present times in the poetry of Keki N. Daruwalla, a poet known for his powerful use of the landscape of northern India in order to address issues such as development, environmental consciousness and the widening gap between the ideal of democracy and the realities that counter such ideals. The landscape becomes a site where these issues contend with each other, reflecting a nation that has become too distanced from the nationalist formulations of India right after its independence.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (the ‘Agreement’) was made and entered into on this 13th day of July, 2021 by and between:

I’m Every Woman, a Trust registered under Trust Act having its Principal office registered office at No 405 B Block, Amarjyothi Apartments, Kanakapura Road, Jayanagar IV Block, Bangalore 560082 (hereinafter referred to as “**DURGA INDIA**”)

AND

Jhatkaa.org, a Trust registered under Trust Act having its Principal office registered office on 1st floor, Gopala Krishnan Complex, #45/3 Residency Road, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560025.

AND

Department of Women’s Studies, Gauhati University, having its registered office at Jalukbari, Guwahati-781014, Assam, DWS, Gauhati University, shall thereafter collectively be referred to as the “parties” and individually as ‘party/each party/either party **wherever** context permits).

RECITALS:

A. The Parties have agreed to enter into this Agreement on non-exclusive basis with a purpose of entering into a strategic association wherein the parties may identify, acquire and execute joint projects/programs/interventions of mutual interest to enable youth to understand, ideate and innovate on the topic of women safety, gender equality and equity (the ‘identified projects’) and thereby protect, support and empower survivors of such exploitation and abuse, especially women and children.

NOW THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL COVENANTS AND PROMISES MADE HEREINAFTER THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1: OBJECTIVE OF STRATEGIC ALLIANCE

The aim and objective of this strategic association between the parties is to look for identified projects pertaining to common objectives and thereafter acquire and execute such identified projects by pooling their resources and expertise.



2: TERRITORY

The rights and obligations contained herein shall relate to the territorial limits of the Republic of India. Thus, the parties shall be free to acquire and execute joint identified projects anywhere in India without restrictions of geographical limits of state/s.

3: ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The parties agree to perform under this agreement and discharge their responsibilities as per 'Roles and Responsibilities of Parties' given below:

Durga's Responsibilities:

- 1) Orientation with the students about Durga
- 2) Conduct the Gender Curriculum, '*Dissection and Discussion on Gender Gaps in Modern India*' for the students
- 3) Facilitate the Durga Safety workshop
- 4) Baseline assessment of the students
- 5) Durga India will be responsible for identifying 10 durga champions who will act as anchors for the project
- 6) Set-up of the Voice Labs within the campus
- 7) Durga India will be conducting fortnightly capacity building sessions for the Voice Lab members
- 8) Set-up an active Voice Out page
- 9) Weekly meetings with Voice Lab members
- 10) Organising bi-monthly Durga Listens which will be anchored by the Voice Lab members
- 11) Durga India will be training SPOC of the DWS, Gauhati University in documentation for accountability purposes.
- 12) Durga India will be evaluating the needle shift thinking in the students during and after the project is implemented.

Jhatkaa.org's Responsibilities:

- 1) Facilitate the workshop on the Sexual Harassment (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) at the Workplace Act for students
- 2) Provide an illustrated toolkit which explains the aforementioned law in simpler terms
- 3) Assist Durga India with setting up of the Voice Labs within the campus



- 4) Contributing content for capacity building sessions conducted by Durga India as and when they require it

Department of Women's Studies, Gauhati University's Responsibilities:

- 1) The department will act as an institutional partner of Durga India and Jhatkaa.org, in order to integrate the projects specified by Durga India and Jhatkaa.org
- 2) The department will work together with Durga India and Jhatkaa.org to set up a physical room for activities six months from the time of signing the MoU which would be anchored by the students of the institution.
- 3) DWS, Gauhati University will work together with Durga India and Jhatkaa.org to execute mutually identified projects within specific communities and geographical areas.
- 4) DSW, Gauhati University would nominate one SPOC for coordinating all the activities with Durga India and Jhatkaa.org.

List of projects identified:

- 1) **Durga Workshop** - Conduct the Durga Safety Workshop and identify students and train them to become facilitators to conduct workshops for other students in the campus.
- 2) **PoSH Workshop** - Conduct the workshop on the PoSH Act and the role of Internal Committees in colleges.
- 3) **Voice Out** - Creating awareness on cyber bullying and cyber harassment. This project would be focused on understanding appropriate and inappropriate behavior in virtual spaces
- 4) **Voice Lab** - This project will be responsible for creating a physical space within the campus that would act as an anchor in the college campus. The Durga Champions would be the core team that would head the Voice Lab
- 5) **Durga Listens** - Durga Listens, a safe and non-judgemental space that encourages voices from the margins would be organised twice a month.

At the end of each project, the students will be more cognizant of the issue and will be equipped to take care of their own safety. Students will also be expected to write a detailed report which will be submitted to the college, Durga India and Jhatkaa.org. This document will be evaluated by Durga India and Jhatkaa.org. Detailed activities can be found in **Annexure 1** which will form part of this document.

There will be a mutually agreed schedule and timeline for the execution of the above-mentioned projects. Time to time, the parties may jointly agree to add more projects for execution within the said timeline of this agreement. The parties undertake to work diligently and co-operate with each other in order to attain true objectives of their strategic association envisaged herein. Once



the parties mutually decide to work together in respect of any identified project, then project specific roles and responsibilities will be discussed for efficient execution and to avoid any gap or misunderstandings. This being a non-exclusive arrangement, the parties shall be free to enter into similar agreements with other interested parties in the territory. However, relationships between the parties shall be exclusive in respect of any and all identified projects.

4: COPYRIGHT, PATENTS AND OTHER PROPRIETARY RIGHTS

4.1 All copyrights, patents and other intellectual property rights over existing materials (proprietary materials already in existence prior to execution of this agreement) and other materials of the DWS, Gauhati University or Durga India and Jhatkaa.org shall be developed in connection with this agreement with joint effort and contribution of parties shall remain the exclusive property of DWS, Gauhati University, Durga India and Jhatkaa.org and neither party shall challenge such ownership in any manner whatsoever.

4.2 All copyrights, patents and other intellectual property in the manuscripts, records, reports and other materials, except for the existing materials publicly or privately owned, developed or prepared in the course of this agreement with joint effort and contribution, shall remain joint property of the parties. Each party shall have the right to use joint intellectual property for their own use, however commercial exploitation/or further grant-based use of joint intellectual property shall be permissible only with mutual consent of the parties.

4.3 All copyrights, patents and other intellectual property in the manuscripts, records, reports and other materials, except for the existing materials publicly or privately owned, developed or prepared in the course of this agreement with joint effort and contribution, SHALL NOT BE SHARED with a third party without the consent of the other two joint owners of the intellectual property.

5: TERM OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement will remain valid for a period of three year commencing from 13th day of July, 2021, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the provision contained under clause 6 herein. The parties with their mutual consent can extend the validity of this agreement for such a period and upon such terms as may be mutually agreed from time to time.

6: TERMINATION AND EFFECT

- 6.1 This agreement can be terminated before expiry of tenure in the following manner:
- A. Forthwith by mutual consent in writing or in case either party commits breach which by nature cannot be cured, within five (5) working days
 - B. By either party upon giving a one-month (30 calendar days) notice in writing to the other party without assigning any reason.



- 6.2 Post termination or expiry, either Party shall not directly or indirectly identify itself in any manner as a party involved in Business with the other Party. In particular but without prejudice to the foregoing generality, neither Party shall use any of other Party's Trade Marks, Trade Names, Signs, Symbols, Designs, Devices, Insignia, copyrighted material or other distinctive materials, or any deceptively and confusingly similar Trademarks, Trade Names, Signs, Symbols, Devices, Insignia or other distinctive materials.
- 6.3 Notwithstanding termination for any reason whatsoever or expiry of the agreement, the parties will continue to discharge their respective responsibilities to serve all ongoing execution of identified projects pursuant to this agreement till completion. However, no fresh identified project shall be undertaken by the parties after serving termination notice by either party.

7: CONFIDENTIALITY

7.1 All information, documents, data, records, software, files etc. (whether technical, financial or commercial including customer information) in any form, media, whether electronic, digital or optic, communicated/supplied by either party to the other party or acquired during the course of association (hereinafter referred to as "Confidential Information"), shall be deemed to be confidential or proprietary in nature. The Confidential Information shall be held in utmost secrecy, strictest confidence and trust by the receiving party.

7.2 Both parties agree not to directly or indirectly use or permit the use, divulge or disclose such Confidential Information to any third party for any purpose other than for carrying out the obligations under this agreement or statutorily required to be disclosed.

8: INDEMNITY

8.1 Each Party ("Defaulting Party") shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless (i) the other party (ii) each of other party's Affiliates, assigns and successors in interest, as the case may be; and (iii) each of the respective directors and officers of other party from and against any and all losses which may be incurred or suffered by any such party and which may arise out of or result from:

- A. breach of any obligations or covenants of defaulting Party as contained in this Agreement;
- B. acts /omissions in breach of the terms and conditions of this Agreement;
- C. Breach of any laws or regulations applicable to the defaulting Party;
- D. any third-party claims made for loss or damage of whatever description caused to such or any other third party as a result of the activities of the defaulting party; and
- E. any and all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, judgments, costs, expenses, incurred in enforcing this indemnity.



9: MISCELLANEOUS / GENERAL CONDITIONS

9.1: Interpretation The recitals are incorporated in and made a part of this Agreement. Titles of Articles, Sections, Clauses and paragraphs are used for convenience only and are not a part of the Text. All terms used in any one gender shall be construed to include any other gender as the context may require. The singular shall be deemed to include the plural and the plural shall be deemed to refer to the singular as the context may require.

9.2: Entire Agreement This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties and shall prevail over any other Agreement relating to the subject matter hereof. Both Parties declare that they rely upon no representations, conditions, or warranties on the part of the other Party except as herein contained.

9.3: Compliance with Laws Each Party shall be liable for compliance with all applicable statute, legislation, rules, regulations etc in the territory, while working in terms of this Agreement and shall ensure that no non-compliance is committed. Neither Party shall be held liable for the breach of laws and non-compliances by the other Party.

9.4: Waiver The failure of either Party to exercise any right, power or option given to it hereunder, or to insist upon strict compliance with the terms hereof by the other Party shall not constitute a waiver of the terms and conditions of this Agreement with respect to any other or subsequent breach thereof, nor a waiver by the other Party of its rights at any time thereafter to require strict compliance with all the terms thereof. The rights or remedies hereunder are cumulative to any other rights or remedies which may be granted by law.

9.5: Severability In the event that any provision of this Agreement, or any portion thereof, shall be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable under Applicable Law, such defect shall not vitiate the other provisions of the Agreement and the remainder of the Agreement shall continue to be legal, valid, effectual and binding on both the Parties hereto.

9.6: Notices Any notice to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been duly served if sent by prepaid recorded delivery post addressed to the party to be served at its above written address or by email to the registered email address/ID.

9.7: No Agency That either Party shall not be nor shall be deemed to be an agent, legal representative, subsidiary, joint venture or employee of the other Party as a result of this Agreement. Both Parties shall make every effort to ensure that no impression is created to anyone of the existence of any such relationship with the other Party with the public at large.
