





**<u>9.8: Non-Solicitation</u>** DWS, Gauhati University shall not employ any staff of the Durga India and Jhatkaa.org engaged and involved in the performance of this agreement during the period of this agreement and for a further period of 6 months from expiry or termination thereof. Similarly, Durga India and Jhatkaa.org shall also not employ any staff/employee of DWS, Gauhati University during the continuance of this Agreement and for a further period of one year from the expiry or termination of this Agreement for any reason whatsoever.

**<u>9.9: Commercials and Expenses:</u>** No commercials involved whatsoever for the activities. However, actual expenses involved by the members of Durga India for execution of the above projects, would be managed by Durga India. Jhatkaa.org will also send fundraising emails to their members mentioning the work we are doing under this partnership.

### **10: FORCE MAJEURE**

If the performance of this agreement or of any obligation of either party is prevented, restricted or interfered with by reason of fire, explosion, strike, casually or accident, epidemic, cyclone, earthquake, flood or war, revolution, or requirement of any government or any subdivision, authority or representative of any such government, or any other act whatsoever, whether similar or dissimilar to those enumerated, beyond the reasonable control of any or both of the parties hereto; the party so affected, upon giving prompt notice to the other party shall be excused from such performance to the extent of such prevention, restriction or interference for the period it persists, provided that the party so affected shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such causes of non-performance, if possible, and shall continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever such causes are removed.

### **11: ARBITRATION, JURISDICTION AND GOVERNING LAWS**

All claims disputes and differences of whatsoever nature arising out of this Agreement, raised by either of the parties under this Agreement whether during its term or after expiry thereof or prior termination shall be referred for arbitration by a sole Arbitrator appointed with mutual consent of the parties. The venue/place/seat of the Arbitration shall be decided in consent with the parties involved. Arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English language as per the provisions of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modification or reenactment.

The parties agree that only the Courts in the Republic of India shall have jurisdiction to entertain any proceedings related to this Agreement whether during pendency, or after termination. No other Court shall have jurisdiction. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the Laws of India.



Edward Said in Orientalism argues that during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, the West visualised the Orient and the O the Orient as a site where everything in need of correction or containment was situated, so that any image emerging from emerging from such an orientalist perspective would signify the need for surveillance, study, discipline or governing. governing. From this standpoint, Mary Shelley's Frankenstein comes across as an instance of the tendency of Western Faith of Western Enlightenment to assimilate what it deems undesirable and/or threatening in the Orient as the Other, Such Other. Such a reading becomes possible when one looks at the 'oriental' character of Safie (the Arabian) who is transformed in history and literature. She, is transformed into a liberal woman through her 'Western' education steeped in history and literature. She, being a woman through her 'Western' education steeped in history and comments being a woman, implicitly becomes the site of assimilation into the master culture. Safie, moreover, becomes a point of contact between the Western world and the alien world of the monster through her relationship with the De Laceys and as the principal object of the monster also gaze. As she gradually acquires the language, manners, culture and history of England, the monster also begins to enter into the realm of language and culture by emulating Safie's speech and actions. However, the monster's access to Western knowledge does not give him entry into the world of the Enlightened West. Again, while Henry Clerval's interests in Oriental literature and languages is motivated by commercial aspects, Frankenstein is attracted more by the erotic and sexualised landscape that he imaginatively constructs out of his readings of Oriental tales in translation. All these images conjured in the novel become indicative of the way the Orient is otherised by both dominant patriarchal institutions and practices and by the emergent 19th-century feminism. However, the figure of the monster can perhaps be seen as effecting or at least attempting to effect a subtle subversion of such a discourse. My paper will attempt to read Mary Shelley's Frankenstein against the grain through an exploration of these issues.




