



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on the 19th day of December (month), 2022.

BETWEEN

The Aquaculture & Biodiversity Centre Department of Zoology, Gauhati University, Guwahati, Assam (Here in after called 'Gauhati University')

AND

Institute of Inland Fisheries, Potsdam (hereinafter called 'IFB' which expression)

2. SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT AND MODALITIES OF THE CONTRACT

Gauhati University and IfB have established this general agreement to foster inter-institutional cooperation in research activities in the field of fish ecology, inland fisheries and aquaculture involving sharing of technical expertise, knowledge management, applied research, collaborative studies, and capacity development.

2.1. THE GOAL

Gauhati University and IFB will collaborate for research and different extension activities aiming at protection and sustainable, climate-resilient management of fish resources of the NE Region that are suited for the fishermen communities of Assam and NE India.

The two institutions have expressed their intent to jointly support, develop, and demonstrate scalable models, mechanisms, technologies, practices, and knowledge management systems that

- 3.1.1 Can lead to a noteworthy improvement in productivity of indigenous and commercial aquatic species, have the potential to be scaled up and may thereby result in a sustainable increase in incomes of the fishing communities, and
- 3.1.2 Leads to improved knowledge base on the aquatic resources of the region, its validation from the competent authority, assessing the threats to the different aquatic species, publishing & sharing the acquired knowledge jointly through appropriate forums, etc.
- 3.1.3 Improve the adaptability of aquatic biodiversity to climate change and other stressors.

2.2. THE AREAS OF COOPERATION

These may include one or more of the following themes and research areas:

3.2.1. Fishery Ecology:

- 1. Improve knowledge on ecological niche and life history traits of selected endemic fish species.
- 2. Develop methods for and exemplify vulnerability assessment for freshwater fish species of northeast India.





Curricula and Faculty/student /faculty exchange program

- 1. Extending existing curricula at Gauhati University by adding modules in aquaculture and sustainable fishery management.
- 2. Guest lecture of IFB in curricula at Gauhati University.
- 3. Support of faculty & student exchange

Aquaculture

- 1. Development of breeding and larval rearing protocols of selected species.
- 2. Improvement of culture systems under climate change

Fisheries

- 1. Principles of stock assessment.
- 2. Decision modelling and analysis to compare effects of management actions.
- 3. Evaluation of management actions

2.3. MECHANISMS FOR COOPERATION

Both partners will themselves or bilaterally apply for funding of activities under this Memorandum. While the NERAQ-project opens possibilities to agree on and practice first collaborative activities, both partners commit to engage in elaborating on extended funding opportunities to strengthen and advance their partnership beyond NERAQ.

2.4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY, GAUHATI UNIVERSITY AND IFB

- Gauhati University and IFB will extend its general administrative and scientific support to foster a bilateral collaboration.
- The University and IFB will open their research facilities, including laboratories, books, journals, thesis, etc. for use by the others staff and other Consultants specifically engaged in this project to facilitate the inventory process as well as related research works aiming at conservation of aquatic resources.
- During implementation of any joint programme and when there is a need to use the
 infrastructure belonging to Gauhati University and IFB like meeting/seminar halls, guest house
 and other logistical facility, all will be provided by the two partners if available for use.
- The University will deploy its students as intern/ Project Fellow to IFB whenever an opportunity for such internship/Project Fellow in the ongoing projects exists and provided that capacity and resources for mentoring are available at IfB. The IfB will support University staff and students in applying for exchange opportunities, but reserves the right to limit these activities based on applicant qualifications, capacities, and mentoring resources.





- The IFB agrees to work closely alongside of university staff and other regional partners to
 ensure that activities and outputs are locally applicable, with training activities developed
 collaboratively to also target appropriate knowledge transfer.
- The IFB will enable and plan in-person visits of staff who are appropriately trained and prepared to carry out project activities.
- The research findings of collaborative works and for other scientific publications like proceedings, books, papers, etc. will be published jointly. Guidelines for best scientific practices in publishing will be jointly agreed and used to jointly determine authorship and order of authors during the preparation and prior to submission of all publications.
- Gauhati University will facilitate collaborations with other departments of cross-cutting importance such as social science departments that are felt necessary for sustainable use of aquatic resources of the region.
- The two organizations agree to encourage the above-mentioned activities, particularly to strengthen protection, conservation, and sustainable management of aquatic biodiversity, in accordance with their operational capacities, technical knowledge, and available resources.
- Both organisations shall discuss and agree to working on joint activities before or upon the commencement of each activity.
- Activity agreements should detail the objectives, outcomes, outputs, and activities, as well as the budget and contribution of resources provided by each party, and/or any other funding sources, before or upon the commencement of each activity.
- This general MOU shall be applicable to educational, research, extension, and developmental
 activities of both organizations involved in this MOU.
- Financial contribution for the collaborative project will be generated jointly or individually by submitting proposals to German-based funding agencies. Travel and lodging/boarding expenses of the scientists visiting the project areas to Gauhati University or IFB Potsdam may have to be borne by project funding in accordance with project norms and regulations. Otherwise, each partner will bear the costs emerging from activities under this memorandum by itself.

3. STEERING MECHANISM

4.1. Both the organizations will meet periodically for assessing the progress made on the agreed points and whenever necessary, new measures may be proposed to achieve the targeted goals based on this MoU.

4. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

4.1. Joint declaration: The parties recognise the importance of the generation of research results/products as intellectual assets and intellectual property as an integral part of their research agenda. As such, any results or products jointly or individually generated out of the work carried out under the terms or framework of this MoU shall be managed in a way to maximise their global availability and impact for





aquatic biodiversity with mutual acceptance especially in India but also in other countries. The parties consider the release of their research results/products into the public domain as international public goods as their main strategy for achieving global availability.

- 4.2. The ownership of the intellectual property that existed prior to the commencement of this MoU, held by any of the parties, shall not be altered or transferred by virtue of its use hereunder.
- 4.3. Ownership of the intellectual property created under this MoU may be solely or jointly owned by the parties. Specific provisions relating to intellectual property rights will be evaluated and defined in each activity agreement.

5. FORCE MAJEURE

- 5.1. Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective intentions under this agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to Acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strike, lockouts, epidemics, riots, civil commotions etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such events, the party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation.
- 5.2. If the force-majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

6. NON-BINDING NATURE

Nothing in this MoU shall be understood or construed as a binding right or obligation of the parties or as obligating the undersigning parties hereto, to finally conclude any agreement. In particular, this MoU in no way restricts either party from pursuing similar activities on its own or from participating in similar activities with other public or private agencies, organizations, and individuals, and shall not provide exclusivity between the parties in the scope of any cooperation, does not endorse a specific entity, does not create any rights in any person, and does not create any obligations for any third party.

7. EFFECTIVE DATE, DURATION AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

- **7.1.** The agreement shall be effective for a period of up to 5 **years** from the date of signing of the MoU and may be extended further by mutual consent.
- 7.2. The agreement shall be deemed to expire on completion of the mutually agreed upon period.
- **7.3.** This agreement may be terminated early for the following reasons:
 - By mutual agreement among the parties; and
 - Unilaterally, by either party upon notice to the other party in writing, ninety (90) days in advance.
- 7.4. Termination will not affect a specific activity under implementation at the time of written notice.
- 7.5. In the event of termination of the agreement, the rights and obligations of the parties shall be settled by mutual consent/agreement.





8. AMENDMENTS OF THE AGREEMENT

- 8.1. No amendments or modification of this agreement shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties through their authorised representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this agreement.
- 8.2. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date of signature unless otherwise agreed to by the parties.

11. ASSIGNMENT OF THE AGREEMENT

The right and /or liabilities arising to any party out of this agreement shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the other party and subject to such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

12. ARBITRATION

- 12.1 The parties will make all efforts to fulfil the purposes set out within this Agreement.
- 12.2 This Agreement is a good will arrangement which reflects the current understanding of each of the parties and does not create a legally binding obligation under international law or under the parties' applicable domestic law.
- 12.3 Any conflict arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this overarching framework collaboration agreement will be settled amicably by the parties through consultation and will not be referred to any court or tribunal.



Edward Said in Orientalism argues that during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, the West visualised the Orient and Orientalism argues that during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, the West visualised the Orient as a site where everything in need of correction or containment was situated, so that any image emerging from emerging from such an orientalist perspective would signify the need for surveillance, study, discipline or governing. governing. From this standpoint, Mary Shelley's Frankenstein comes across as an instance of the tendency of Western Fatt. of Western Enlightenment to assimilate what it deems undesirable and/or threatening in the Orient as the Other, Such and the Arabian who Other. Such a reading becomes possible when one looks at the 'oriental' character of Safie (the Arabian) who is transformed in history and literature. Joyce Zonana comments that writers to that writers like Mary Wollstonecraft, Elizabeth Barrett Browning and Margaret Fuller employed images of an oppressive Control of the master culture. an oppressive Orient to critique patriarchal practices in their own culture, so as to engender possibilities for and to create a case for women's freedom and independence in Western culture (a process she terms "feminist orientalism"). Safie, moreover, becomes a point of contact between the Western world and the alien world of the monster through her relationship with the De Laceys and as the principal object of the monster's gaze. As she gradually acquires the language, manners, culture and history of England, the monster also begins to enter into the realm of language and culture by emulating Safie's speech and actions. However, the monster's access to Western knowledge does not give him entry into the world of the Enlightened West. Again, while Henry Clerval's interests in Oriental literature and languages is motivated by commercial aspects, Frankenstein is attracted more by the erotic and sexualised landscape that he imaginatively constructs out of his readings of Oriental tales in translation. All these images conjured in the novel become indicative of the way the Orient is otherised by both dominant patriarchal institutions and practices and by the emergent 19th-century feminism. However, the figure of the monster can perhaps be seen as effecting or at least attempting to effect a subtle subversion of such a discourse. My paper will attempt to read Mary Shelley's Frankenstein against the grain through an exploration of these issues.
