

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this day of 27 June, 2023 between the Department of Library & Information Science, Gauhati University, Guwahati, Assam-781014, India - The First Party; herein referenced as "DLIS, GU"

And

Department of Library & Information Science, Cotton University, Guwahati, Assam-781001, India as the Second party; herein together referenced as "DLIS, CU"

Gauhati University is the oldest and largest university in the North-Eastern part of the county established in the year 1948 and has celebrated its Platinum Jubilee in the year 2023. Being the oldest and the largest university in the entire Northeast, the university represents the academic and cultural background of the region, on which the other academic institutions of Northeast India started their journey. Being the pioneer educational institute, it extends its hand holding support to all subsequent academic institutions in this region. Gauhati University is an affiliating University. The university has a huge academic structure with 49 Postgraduate Academic Departments, 2 constituent institutes, 1 constituent college and 300+ affiliated colleges. The Department of Library and Information Science, Gauhati University is the first post graduate and premier department of library and information science in the entire North-East India established in 1966 with Bachelor of Library Science (B.Lib.Sc.) programme. In the year 1979, one-year Master of Library Science (M.Lib.Sc.) programme was introduced. Both the B.Lib.Sc. and M.Lib.Sc. programmes become one-year full time day programme in the year 1983, and in the year 1985, the programmes were re-structured into Bachelor of Library and Information Science (B.L.I.Sc.) and Master of Library and Information Science (M.L.I.Sc.), respectively with major changes in the syllabus as per the UGC guideline. The department started Ph.D. programme in 1987. Again, as per UGC guidelines two years integrated M.L.I.Sc. programme with four semesters has been introduced in the academic session 2001-02 in place of the earlier one-year B.L.I.Sc and M.L.I.Sc prgramme. The department launched M.Phil. programme in the year 2016 but discontinued in the year 2021 as per UGC regulation 2018. Along with the University, the syllabus of the M.L.I.Sc. programme has been switched over to Learning Outcome based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) accommodating all probable dimensions of developments in the subject as well as the demands witnessed in the skills of learners towards reaching out to the expectations of the diverse work environments, both government and corporate sectors.

Cotton College is known as a leading educational hub for its rich heritage and legacy of nurturing new generations to get themselves equip with the challenges of time and thereby lead the country towards prosperity. Cotton University has been established with the commitment of the Cotton College to carry forward the rich legacy. Department of Library & Information Science, Cotton University, established in the year 2019 as a new department in Cotton University. The Department of Library & Information Science, Cotton University started two-year integrated Post Graduate programme Master of Library & Information Science (M.L.I.Sc.) in the year 2020. The department has started PhD programme in the year 2023. The syllabus of the department has been aligned to the state-of-the art national and global standards in the field of library & information science. The department has put significant thrust to train the learners and get themselves adapted with the necessary skill in the frontier areas of information management and innovation. - 2. Collaborative Research Projects Faculty members of DLIS, GU and DLIS, CUmay undertake joint research projects and submit proposals for possible funding to different funding agencies.
- 3. **Joint organization of Seminar/ Symposia/ Workshop** —Seminar/Symposia/Workshop may be organized jointly by the DLIS, GU and DLIS, CU.
- 4. **Training and Internship of Students** Both the University departments will give due priority to the students of each other University in pursuance of summer and/ or winter internship programmes as and when organized, and extend necessary help and guidance to undergo similar programmes in the University libraries of both the universities.
- 5. Training and Career Counseling Both the University departments may jointly organize special training programme for different competitive examinations, and programme of career counseling at convenient time on mutual consultation.
- 6. **Placement of Students** Both the University departments may help each other to provide placement opportunities to the students based on eligibility and industry requirements.
- 7. **Financial Obligation**—This is a non-binding MoU and there shall be no financial obligations on any of the parties with regard to execution and realization of the above stated areas of collaboration.

Both DLIS, GU and DLIS, CU agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this MoU will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose covered by this MoU, unless such information, that was obtained by a third party who do not have obligation of confidentiality towards the information-disclosing party and has entered public domain.

The following principles will be abided by regarding termination of this MoU.

o This MoU shall enter into effect from the date of signing and shall be valid for a period of three years.

o Nothing mentioned in this MoU shall be deemed to constitute partnership between the signing universities or university departments appointing one party as the agent of the other.

This MoU will be effective upon signature by both the Registrars of Gauhati University and Cotton University. The Head of the Departments of DLIS Gauhati University and DLIS Cotton University will act as nodal officers for execution of the academic activities in the MoU.



However, the monster's access to Western knowledge does not give him entry into the world of the Enlightened West. Again, while Henry Clerval's interests in Oriental literature and languages is motivated by commercial aspects, Frankenstein is attracted more by the erotic and sexualised landscape that he imaginatively constructs out of his readings of Oriental tales in translation. All these images conjured in the novel become indicative of the way the Orient is otherised by both dominant patriarchal institutions and practices and by the emergent 19th-century feminism. However, the figure of the monster can perhaps be seen as effecting or at least attempting to effect a subtle subversion of such a discourse. My paper will attempt to read Mary Shelley's Frankenstein against the grain through an exploration of these issues.
