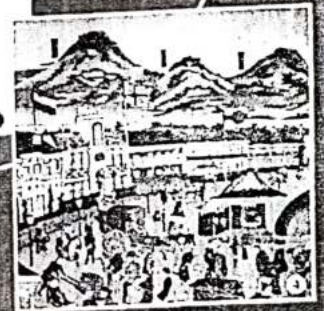
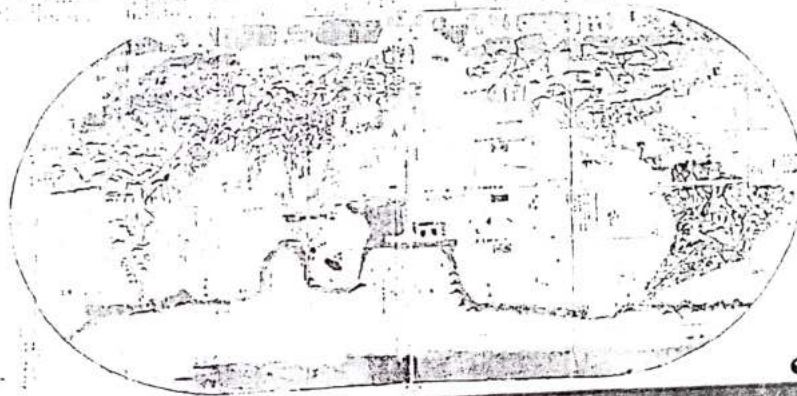

Surveillance and Subversion in Mary Shelley's *Frankenstein*

Edward Said in *Orientalism* argues that during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, the West visualised the Orient as a site where everything in need of correction or containment was situated, so that any image emerging from such an orientalist perspective would signify the need for surveillance, study, discipline or governing. From this standpoint, Mary Shelley's *Frankenstein* comes across as an instance of the tendency of Western Enlightenment to assimilate what it deems undesirable and/or threatening in the Orient as the Other. Such a reading becomes possible when one looks at the 'oriental' character of Safie (the Arabian) who is transformed into a liberal woman through her 'Western' education steeped in history and literature. She, being a woman, implicitly becomes the site of assimilation into the master culture. Joyce Zonana comments that writers like Mary Wollstonecraft, Elizabeth Barrett Browning and Margaret Fuller employed images of an oppressive Orient to critique patriarchal practices in their own culture, so as to engender possibilities for and to create a case for women's freedom and independence in Western culture (a process she terms "feminist orientalism"). Safie, moreover, becomes a point of contact between the Western world and the alien world of the monster through her relationship with the De Laceys and as the principal object of the monster's gaze. As she gradually acquires the language, manners, culture and history of England, the monster also begins to enter into the realm of language and culture by emulating Safie's speech and actions. However, the monster's access to Western knowledge does not give him entry into the world of the Enlightened West. Again, while Henry Clerval's interests in Oriental literature and languages is motivated by commercial aspects, *Frankenstein* is attracted more by the erotic and sexualised landscape that he imaginatively constructs out of his readings of Oriental tales in translation. All these images conjured in the novel become indicative of the way the Orient is otherised by both dominant patriarchal institutions and practices and by the emergent 19th-century feminism. However, the figure of the monster can perhaps be seen as effecting or at least attempting to effect a subtle subversion of such a discourse. My paper will attempt to read Mary Shelley's *Frankenstein* against the grain through an exploration of these issues.

Coleridge's "Clerisy" and Confucianism in "The American Scholar": How They Inspired Ralph Waldo Emerson

It is known that Emerson was an extensive reader and learned widely from authors from various countries. Among these authors, Coleridge and Confucius occupied significant places. In this paper, I would focus attention on the influence of Samuel Taylor Coleridge's idea of "clerisy" and Confucian thought on Emerson's argument on such central topics as scholars' relationship with "nature" and "past," and their "actions" — the duties they are expected to perform in society — in "The American Scholar" (1837).

Coleridge's *On the Constitution of the Church and State* (hereafter *Church and State*), *Statesman's Manual*, and *The Friends* were the books Emerson read with enthusiasm since the mid 1820s. As early as 1830, Emerson became interested in Chinese philosophy, and he read *Analects of Confucius* (1809) translated by Joshua Marshman in 1836, when he was working on the themes which would be materialized in "The American Scholar." His journals and notebook entries show that he was interested in the words of Confucius which related to human relationship including humanities (仁) and filial piety (孝), and learned men's duties in society.

I would like to show that Coleridge and Confucius are playing complementing roles each other in the mind of Emerson. In *Church and State*, Coleridge divided "clerisy" into two groups according to the — The first group consists of a smaller number of pioneering people who expand the

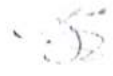

CREATING "A FEEL OF HOME":
AN EXPLORATION OF THE ROLE OF MIGRANT WOMEN
IN A CHANGE OF SKIES AND BONE CHINA

Nipuni Ranaweera

This paper is based on my observations on the role of women in the works of two expatriate Sri Lankan authors; namely, *A Change of Skies* by Yasmine Gooneratne and *Bone China* by Roma Tearne. I would like to consider the roles of women in expatriate settings in these works in the light of Deniz Kandiyoti's argument in "Identity and its Discontents: Women and the Nation." Her position that women, and more significantly migrant women, are expected to be the "custodians of cultural particularisms" in expatriate settings would be looked at closely in relation to the female characters in these works. I will look at the particular ways in which women strive to retain a feel of "Home," and the manner in which these attempts reflect on these women's identities. I would be employing these characters to argue that women are largely held responsible for "creating a feel of Home" in exilic conditions. While this may be seen to limit their assimilation into the host culture, I hope to maintain that they are often the key to creating cross cultural links with the host culture/other culture.

REREADING THE NATION IN POSTCOLONIAL
INDIAN ENGLISH POETRY

Dolikajyoti Sharma

In their account of India's ecological history, *This Fissured Land: An Ecological History of India*, Madhav Gadgil and Ramachandra Guha trace the transformation of the nation from its pre-modern past through its colonial and postcolonial history to its contemporary mosaic of development and poverty, conservation and misuse of natural resources. The ideals of freedom and prosperity in post-independence India have given way to poverty, corruption and bureaucratic indifference. Given such a context, it is interesting to look at how contemporary Indian poetry in English has responded to the ecological aspect of envisioning the Indian nation. Taking off from these issues, this paper attempts to locate the idea of India in present times in the poetry of Keki N. Daruwalla, a poet known for his powerful use of the landscape of northern India in order to address issues such as development, environmental consciousness and the widening gap between the ideal of democracy and the realities that counter such ideals. The landscape becomes a site where these issues contend with each other, reflecting a nation that has become too distanced from the nationalist formulations of India right after its independence.

- organizing talks, seminars and scientifically-based reunions;
- an exchange of documents and scientific and pedagogical publications;
- developing programmes and teaching cycles which are considered useful for both parties.

ARTICLE 2 - Fields of Application

Both contracting parties foresee an active co-operation in the field of some potential medicinal plants and their associated microbes of North East India, and in particular in the isolation and chemical and biological characterization of bioactive compounds and metabolites produced by these natural products.

- under the form of short visits (conferences, talks, seminars, workshops)

Every year the number of personnel will be agreed upon reciprocally (up to a maximum of five) who will take part in the exchange, as well as the length of the mission.

With regard to the exchange students, they will have to pay their university fees for their own country.

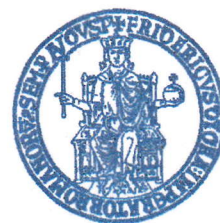



This memorandum of understanding, MoU is made and entered into this Eighteenth Day of Two Thousand Ten between **Gauhati University** herein and thereafter mentioned as 'GU', a centre of higher learning, established by an Act in the State Assembly, and having its registered office at Copinath Bordoloi Nagar, Jalukbari, Guwahati-781014, Assam

AND

Dr. Bhubaneswar Borooah Cancer Institute herein and thereafter mentioned as 'Dr.BBCI', a Regional Institute for Cancer Treatment and Research is a Autonomous Body funded by Department of Atomic Energy, Govt. of India, North-Eastern Council, Govt. of India and the Govt. of Assam, which was registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860, having its registered office at Copinath Nagar, A. N. Azad Road, Guwahati-781016, hereinafter called the Dr.BBCI.

1. Preamble

The Department of Physics under the Gauhati University is a fast growing department which was started in the year 1954 with the primary objectives of developing quality manpower in the form of teachers and scientists in the field of different areas of physics. Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute is a recognized Institute for cancer treatment & research, which can act as a platform for broad based collaboration between Department of Physics, GU and Dr.BBCI. Both Department of Physics, GU and Dr.BBCI can be mutually supportive and beneficial for the common cause of advancement of academic quality by introducing specialized new course in the field of Radiological Physics for the benefit of the people of the country and the north eastern region in particular.

2. Purpose and Objectives

The purpose of this MoU is to create a frame work for a platform of collaboration with the following specific objectives:

- (a) To establish a close linkage and functional coordination between Department of Physics, GU and Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute
- (b) To recognize Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute as an accredited centre for study and research by Gauhati University, Guwahati.
- (c) To introduce Radiological Physics as a separate discipline for teaching and training by Department of Physics, GU and Dr.BBCI to fill up the shortage of medical physicists in the country and north eastern region in particular for the benefit of radiation oncology and allied discipline.
- (d) To offer 2 years (Semester System) plus 1 year, internship Post Graduate course (M.Sc.) in Radiological Physics leading to M.Sc. Degree jointly by Dr.BBCI and GU and to assess and accredit the skilled based teaching programme offered by the Department of Radiation Oncology of Dr.BBCI as well as the Dept. of Physics, GU which may make it possible for awarding Post Graduate degree by the Gauhati University in future.
- (e) The minimum qualification for admission into the course will be B.Sc. with Physics as major subject.
- (f) To create / develop new experimental / theoretical facilities in both the institutes through mutual cooperation of Dr.BBCI and Department of Physics, GU and exchange ideas from various experts.
- (g) To make joint effort to conduct research, training and consultancy in the areas of health in India and abroad and to facilitate generation of fund for this purpose jointly by both the parties.
- (h) Any earning and expenditure for the purpose of this course / any related matter under this MoU made by both the institutes should be made transparent by both the institutes to each other.
- (i) All policy matters relating to academics, examinations, administration and finance of the course will be decided by an Executive Committee constituted by members of both the Institutes.



At-least six members of the Executive Committee will be required to form a quorum for an Executive Committee meeting. The Chairman or Co-Chairman may invite one or more experts as special invitee for a meeting for taking expert opinion if they feel that such opinion is required on certain issues.

3. Responsibilities of Dr.BBCI:

- a) Dr.BBCI shall conduct the In-House-Training as per the training programme for the students.
- b) Dr.BBCI shall arrange for apprenticeship/internship for the students in the Dr.BBCI or other health centre during the third year of the programme. In case a health centre discontinues training support to the student, Dr.BBCI may make alternative arrangement with another centre for the students. In case the second centre finds the students not suitable or otherwise, the responsibility of providing apprenticeship/internship shall lie with the Dr.BBCI.
- c) Dr.BBCI shall not make any financial commitment on behalf of the University nor shall create any financial liability binding Gauhati University under this MOU.
- d) Dr.BBCI shall have all employees working with Dr.BBCI on their payrolls and the University shall have no legal, financial or any other responsibility towards the Dr.BBCI employees and vice versa.
- e) Dr.BBCI shall follow the course curriculum provided by the University from time to time.
- f) Dr.BBCI shall promote, conduct and monitor the programme through its network and Gauhati University as per the guidelines issued by Gauhati University from time to time.
- #g) Dr.BBCI shall advertise the programme in leading national dailies in the name of Gauhati University and promote the course at its own cost.
- # h) Dr.BBCI shall be responsible for preparation and the printing of the prospectus of the programmes in consultation with Department of Physics, Gauhati University. The cost of prospectus shall be borne by the Dr.BBCI and sales proceeds of prospectus shall be kept by Dr.BBCI.
- # i) Dr.BBCI in association with the Department of Physics, GU shall conduct the entrance examination for admission into M.Sc. in Radiological Physics. Gauhati University may appoint an observer for the same. The venue of the test will be DR.BBCI or Dept. of Physics, GU. The list of the eligible candidates will be published by Dr.BBCI after being approved by Chairman / Co-Chairman of the Executive Committee.

j) Dr.BBCI shall accept the application forms, registration fees, examination fee and such other fee as required for admission into GU from the eligible candidates in the form of Demand Draft payable to Registrar, Gauhati University, Guwahati. Dr.BBCI shall not accept any cash payment on behalf of Gauhati University.

k) Dr.BBCI shall forward the application forms for registration along with the collected fees and the documents of the students to Gauhati University within twenty days from the last date of admission.

l) Dr.BBCI shall ensure Classroom, Faculty, Library, Computer labs and the other Medical Instrumentation facilities as per the norms and standard laid down by Gauhati University for the smooth conduct and completion of both the theoretical and practical sessions related to the subject relevant to Dr.BBCI. Some facilities (instruments and expertise) which are found to be not available at Dr.BBCI and GU at present will be arranged by Dr.BBCI in collaboration with some at par technical Institutes, universities etc. from time to time.

m) Dr.BBCI shall provide assistance for conduct of the semester examinations as desired by Gauhati University. The expenditure related to semester examinations (remuneration to invigilators of examinations, script evaluators, TA/DA to external examiners) shall be borne by Gauhati University. The venue of the semester examinations may be Dr.BBCI, Dept. of Physics, GU or both.

n) Dr.BBCI shall collect from the candidates (declared eligible) for admission into the M.Sc. course in Radiological Physics, the prescribed course fee of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand only) at the time of admission in the 1st Semester and Rs.30,000/- as registration fee in each of the subsequent semesters. In addition, Dr.BBCI shall collect the affiliation fee, and equivalent determinant fee (for non-GU students) as per GU rule and rate and pay to GU at the time of admission. The above amount must be paid in the form of Demand Draft payable to Registrar, Gauhati University, Guwahati. During the period of internship no fee will be applicable to the students.

o) Revision of above fees may be done only with approval of the Executive Committee of the Course.

p) Dr.BBCI shall develop a website related to the proposed course in M.Sc. in Radiological Physics of the University and Gauhati University shall provide a link in their official website, there to.


q) The TA/DA of University officials for inspection shall be borne by Dr.BBCI as per University rule.

r) Dr.BBCI must affiliate to GU by paying the prescribed fee for the purpose.

4. Responsibilities of Gauhati University:

- b) Gauhati University shall frame the course structure and the syllabus and forward the same to Dr.BBCI before the commencement of the academic session.
 - c) Gauhati University shall supply hall tickets/admit cards to students enrolled on receipt of the examination forms and the fees prescribed. The supply of hall tickets/admit cards shall be made at least 30 days before the commencement of the examination.
 - d) Gauhati University administration shall conduct examinations and the subsequent evaluation of the answer scripts leading to the declaration of the result within 45 days from the last date of examination.
 - f) Gauhati University shall transfer Dr.BBCI's share of the course fees within 30 days of submission of the Admission/Re-Registration forms.
 - g) Gauhati University shall monitor academic standard and along with Dr.BBCI shall exercise control over the program.
 - h) Gauhati University shall arrange Physics related classes (both theory and practical) at the department of Physics, GU.
 - i) Gauhati University shall award the M.Sc. Degree to the students who will be declared successful in the examination.


5. **Financial Implications:**

- a) The share of Gauhati University shall be 25% of the course fee.
- b) The share of Dr.BBCI shall be 75% of course fee. Out of this amount, the Dr.BBCI will pay remuneration to teachers (of both GU and Dr.BBCI) for taking classes, remunerations to two coordinators of the course, development of infrastructure facilities at both the institutes (i.e., at Department of Physics, GU and Dr.BBCI, Guwahati) and all other expenses related to the course.
- c) Dr.BBCI shall pay to GU the cost of printing and setting of the question papers.
- d) Dr.BBCI shall pay a sum of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees two lac only) at the time of signing the MOU in the form of Demand Draft Payable to the "Registrar Gauhati University, Guwahati" as refundable security deposit which shall not earn any interest. The security amount shall be refunded at the time of expiry or termination of the MOU.
- e) The registration and other fees which will be collected from the students by Dr.BBCI must be sent to GU at the time of admission / re-registration and there shall be no sharing.
- f) The Executive Committee reserves the right to revise the fees included in this course.
- g) Executive Committee has the right to alter at any point of time the percentage of fund sharing.

6. **Additional Responsibility:**

Gauhati University shall assign any additional responsibility to Dr.BBCI as it may consider necessary for the qualitative conduct of the programme in consultation with Dr.BBCI.

7. Force Majeure:

In the event of non fulfillment of any of the terms and conditions as laid in this MOU because of any force majeure viz. war, fire, strike, natural calamities, etc. or any such situations arising out of national policy and/or Court's verdict and from any regulatory authority, neither Dr.BBCI nor the Gauhati University shall be responsible for any loss or losses.

8. Indemnity:

9. Intellectual Property Rights

Any application for intellectual property (IP) rights through the collaborative study Programmes under this MoU shall be filed jointly by Department of Physics, GU on behalf of GU and Dr.BBCI.

10. Liabilities:

Gauhati University shall not be liable towards any financial claim or claims of any other nature by any person/s made on Dr.BBCI. Gauhati University shall not be liable for any liability arising out of infringement of copyright or by use of pirated software by Dr.BBCI if it so happens. Dr.BBCI shall not be held liable for any delay in examination or lapses in the conduct of examination as they shall always be under the purview of Gauhati University.

11. Amendments:

Any amendment in to the MoU may be incorporated only with the consent of authorities of GU and Dr. BBCI with approval of the Executive Committee.

12. Breach of Agreement:

In case of breach of any condition of this MOU, the MOU can be terminated with a six months notice from either side. However, students admitted to the course, before the expiry or termination, will be allowed to complete their course and appear in the examinations normally. The obligations of both the parties shall remain in force till the time all enrolled students have appeared in their examinations. Moreover --

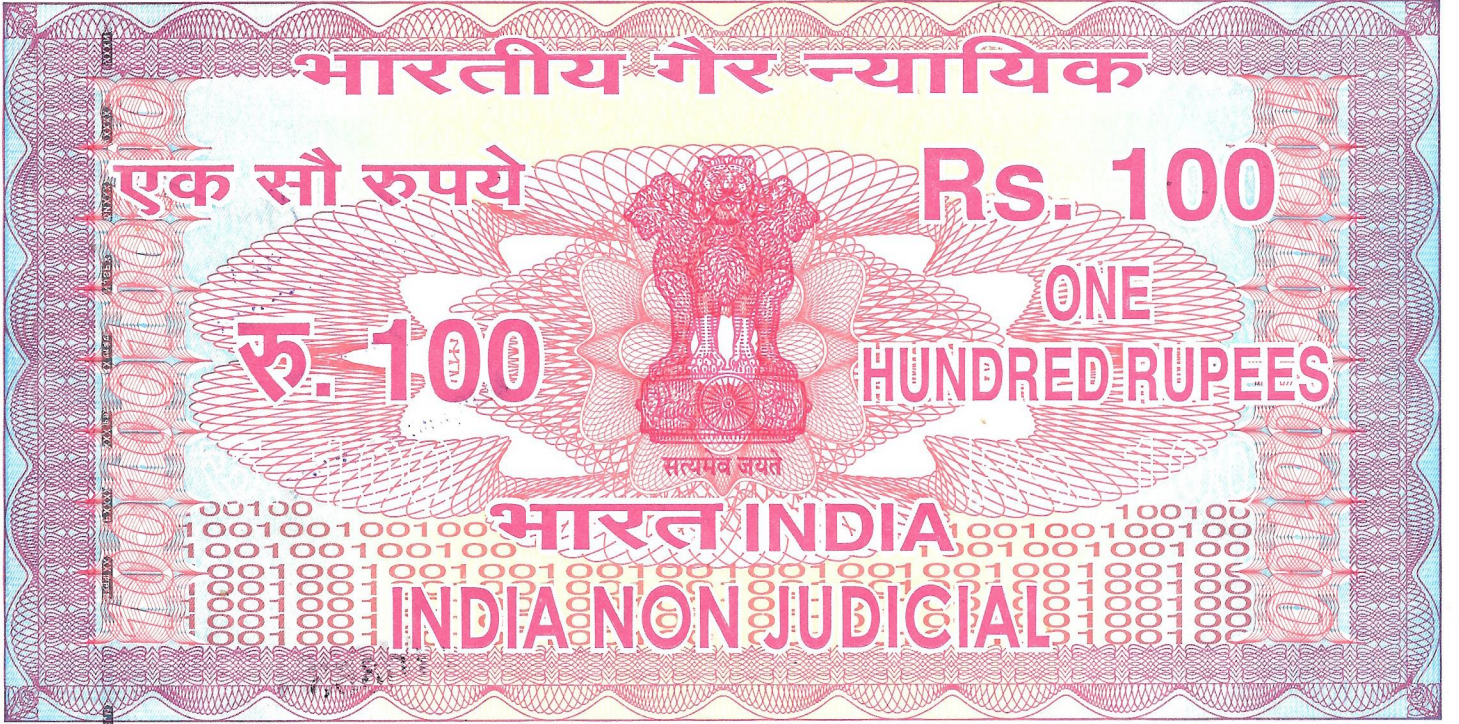
