

Institute that will confer the Degree. In other way, this will define the amount of credits that could be transferred from other institutes in a span of a degree.

5. Minimum Common Academic Calendar

A common Academic Calendar which contains the minimum structure of starting and ending of an academic session for FYUGP needs to be decided so that this will facilitate students to have the opportunity of multiple entries and exits and also the flexibility of earning credits from different HEI within a stipulated time frame.

Stages of Degree programmes and promotion of mobility shall demand synchronization of academic activities across the HEIs of the state. Students Internship, Industry and Social engagement for Project Works, acquiring Skills through outreach engagements etc shall require uniform timeline for Campus and Classroom/Examination engagements. If few structural homogeneities could be adopted among all the Universities in terms of the timeline of the Academic session activities, there shall be great flexibility and easiness. Such structural homogeneity may have included properly defined Uniform Academic Session with Starting and Ending of the Session, Duration- Starting-Ending of Odd and Even Semesters, Similar Semester/Winter/Summer break duration etc.

6. Adopting digital enablement

Digital tools, technologies, and applications have changed the way academics are planned, learned, delivered, and administered. In order to implement the NEP 2020 in an effective manner, digital enablement of various stages, activities, and resources must be expanded and practiced.

Creation of digital course repositories, resources and putting those in respective Universities' digital presence shall facilitate expansion of knowledge universe through unrestricted and encouraged sharing. Uniform presence of all the HEIs in the ABC (Academic Bank of Credits), and facilitating different mutual and inter-university processes through digital platforms shall effectively enhance the implementation and execution of NEP 2020.

7. Policy on self-financing course and recruitment of guest / contractual / tenure-track faculty

Considering the enhancement of student enrolment in HEIs and the requirement of infrastructure, it may be considered to allow for the introduction of self-finance and add-on courses by the individual HEIs and the required human resources for such self-finance course may be recruited as guest/contractual/tenure-track faculty through a reasonably uniform process of with a suitable uniform remuneration structure.

Government may adopt uniform/minimum structure of fees for Self-Financing courses particularly for Colleges. Government may also consider minimum salary structure for Contractual/Tenure-Track faculty positions against temporary vacant positions of Teaching staff in colleges to ensure quality education. Administrative process in this regard may be simplified and a structured and decentralized-empowered process to be in place in order to facilitate uninterrupted delivery of academics in the colleges in particular.

8. Common entrance Tests for UG and PG Admissions

At various levels and forums, including the Government, matter of unification of and simplification of Entrance Tests for both UG and PG levels has been raised. Whereas it is already a practice in case of engineering and medical, College and University admissions for both UG and PG in almost all other programmes are through discrete and individual entrance/selection process. For the benefit of the entire student community, to add enhanced simplicity to the admission process, a discussion may be initiated in the matter of common entrance test for UG and PG admissions in the state Universities and Colleges.

9. Decentralization of Syllabus Framing:

Syllabus framing is a very essential and serious component in academics, and critical to the quality assurance. In an affiliating structure, Universities play major and centralized role in framing syllabi for the curriculum the University offers. Representations from affiliated Institutes are also included in the process as members of the board of studies or syllabus preparation committee. Whereas involvement and exposure to this process is automatic for the faculty members in the University department, not all the faculty members and institutes in the affiliating structure are involved in the process. This has resulted a natural lesser-exposure of the colleges to the entire process of syllabus framing.

Implementation of NEP 2020 shall demand complete academic expertise at the level of degree offering institutes over a period of time in coming years. This shall pose a serious challenge to handle the gap of expertise-requirement in curriculum detailing and syllabus framing. Curriculum detailing and syllabus framing requires expertise in credit assigning to chunk of content, appropriately handle the statics and dynamics of coverage in the domain, and suitable synchronization and innovations with contemporary knowledge paradigm. Universities may discuss in adopting a systematic and progressive strategic action plan and timeline for capacity building of the respective components in the affiliating structure, so that by the time the colleges or cluster of colleges need their own major role in curriculum detailing and syllabus framing, they become capable by acquiring expanded and adequate expertise.

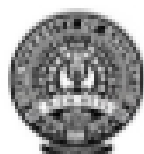

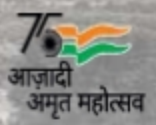

Seminar on Partition and NE India organized

GUWAHATI, Aug 14: "The borders and the reasons of the Partition of India are the outcome of the imperial way of geographical demarcation of the boundaries without physical verification of people and its culture," said Prof H Handique, Vice-Chancellor of Gauhati University while inaugurating the seminar on Partition and Northeast India: Human Tragedies and Political Uncertainties organized as a part of the Partition Horrors Remembrance Day here today.

The seminar was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Gauhati University on the premises of the institution.

With cautious anticipation, in his speech, Prof Handique pointed out that borders are negative in nature, and therefore, the inseparability of it makes us pessimistic.

He also reminded that at the point of Partition, both India and Pakistan were given only dominion status, and only with the commencement of the Constitution of India we have become a Republic. He also asserted that the Republic in the future, for us that can help in saving the country from any trauma and tragedy experienced during the Partition.

Indicating the seminar address in the seminar Prof Udayan Mitra, executive officer and Joint, Department of English, Dibrugarh University said, "Let the Partition become that insight in comprehensible human condition under an umbrella of plurality of lives, faith, and thought."

Prof Mitra, in his address, delved into the reasons and the critical journey, both during the Partition and the post-Partition phase in India and remarked that it were the failures of the Constituent which led to the unwillingness by the former in defining and committing the borders to the nation of diverse race, culture and political structure, because the political system was not well planned by it from the thought.

Chief Guest for the seminar, Prof Handique, he went into the historical point of the Partition process, which was done in a rather insensitive way by the imperial forces and left both the regions of Northeast India unprotected, which continues to haunt us. However, the shared values, the common sentiment and our own justice, and we need to be hopeful about our future.

Prof Handique said that the establishment of the working model for the Constitution of India, which was based on the period of humanism, the grand ideas of Justice, peace and to come out of it through the voice of reconciliation, based on the fundamental principles of mutual tolerance, accommodation, trust, human freedom, social justice and fraternity and upholding the Constitution as the fundamental law of the land.

In his welcome note, Prof Bhabu Tanti, Director, IQAC, GU, also pointed out the fact that the borders of the Partition make us sensitive and responsible citizens, and ensure we re-define ourselves from an act of hatred and exclusion.

Participating as a key speaker in the seminar, Prof Richard Choudhury, Dean, Faculty of Arts, Gauhati University, dealt at length with the literary works of eminent authors, the Bang Sahitya, Khazimur Singh, Dr. Bhabu Saha, Khushwant Singh, Dr. Manu Bhandari and Satish Chakrabarti, who have captured the trauma and tragedy of the Partition.

Dr Bhabu Datta, another key speaker, reminded that, beyond the legacy of Hindu and Muslim, many other communities in Northeast India have been living under shadow of Partition.

Prof Hish Handique, who chaired the technical session, reminded that the consequences of the Partition - ethnic cartography and tensions - create the boundaries and tensions, which we need to overcome.

CM attends Partition Horrors Remembrance Day programme

GUWAHATI, Aug 14: Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma today participated in the Partition Horrors Remembrance Day organised by IIP at JTA Machhewra cemetery.

Speaking on the occasion, the Chief Minister said that August 14, 1947, when India and Pakistan partitioned, will always be remembered as a 'black day' in the Indian history.

Sarma said it was on this day that tragically had hundreds of Indian families crossing loss of human lives and property.

"The main aim of observing this day is to remember the Indian families who had to endure death and forced partition due to partition," he said. He further said that the partition resulted in hatred and violence due to which many had to sacrifice their lives. — Staff Reporter
