GUWAHATI, June 14: Different organisations organised blood donation camps and other activities in the city on the occasion of World Blood Donor Day today.

To mark the occasion, the Gauhati University NSS Cell today started an initiative to prepare a database of voluntary blood donors among NSS programme officers and volunteers.

Dr. Ranjan Kumar Kakati, Director, Student Welfare and Programme Coordinator of the Gauhati University NSS Cell, Dr. Ranjan Kumar Kakati said altogether 166 NSS units have been working under the Gauhati University NSS Cell and each unit has around 100 volunteers.

"We are aiming to prepare a database of 6,000 voluntary blood donors, so that we could help anyone in need," Dr. Kakati told *The Assam Tribune*.

On the occasion of World Blood Donor Day, NSS volunteers of Gauhati University NSS Cell observed World Blood Donor Day on the theme "Give Blood and Keep the World Beating".

Attending a webinar held as part of the observance, Dr. Kasturi Kalita spoke on different positive aspects and technical issues relating to blood donation.

The city-based hospital celebrates the day every year with donors coming from across the State to donate blood. But this year and last year, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, only donors from the city could come to donate.

Altogether 41 donors donated blood today. "We appeal to people to donate more and more blood to help the people in need. This is a time of crisis and if we work together, we can pass this pandemic season," said Anu Choudhury, president of Agnew's Yous Parishad, Guwahati.

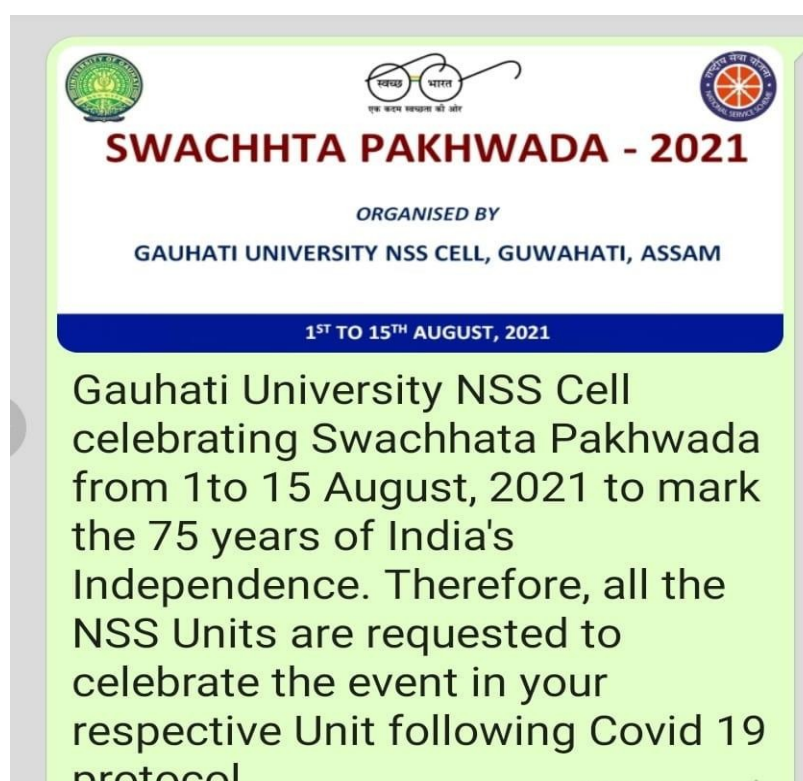
