The Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the members of the Council, specially welcomed all the new members. He requested all the members to extend their support and cooperation 1+11111111111111 while conducting the meeting.

## B. Condolence Resolutions:

The meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.11.2019 mourned the sad demise of Prof. Abdulah Ali Ashraff, HoD, Anthropology, G.U., Prof. Tabu Ram Taid, Prof. Dilip Kumar Dutta, Professor Emeritus of University of Rhote Island, Dr. Parikshit Hazarika, Former HoD, Department of Assamese and Prof. Annada Charan Bhagawati, former Vice-Chancellor of Rajiv Gandi University, Itanagar, retired Professor of G.U. by observing one minute silence.

C. Confirmation of the Proceedings of the last Academic Council meeting held on 7th February, 2019.

"Although the matter of CGPA conversion was discussed in the meeting of Academic Council held on 29/03/2018 and resolved as "Resolved the matter to multiply CGPA x 10 to find the percentage. A notification to be issued with retrospective effect from 2008 where the CGPA earned by a candidate may be converted to equivalent percentage of marks by multiplying the CGPA by 10 (Ten)" which was further confirmed in the meeting of Academic Council held on 07/02/2019. But the decision was not implemented through a Notification because of various representations, objections and concerns raised from various Page 1 of 7

angles subsequently. It is also to be noted that related issues have already reached Gauhati High Court and received court notice. In view of this, the matter needs further discussions."

Subsequent Note from the Controller of Examinations, GU

"The CGPA conversion formula for relative grading system, converts CGPA to percentage of marks using different formulas. It is different for CGPA upto 9.5 and CGPA above 9.5 Also one formula is used for Science, Tech, Eng., Medicine, Com., Management & MBE and another formula is used for Arts, Law & Fine Arts. A 9.5 CGPA of Arts is converted to 67.5%, whereas a 9.9 CGPA is converted to 93.5%.

A 9.5 CGPA at many other Universities are converted to either 95% or 90%. Dissatisfactions on this have been received by this office also.

In view of this a detailed discussion may be required for formulating a academically perfect & student friendly system."

#### Discussed the matter.

The Council is of the opinion that Assamese language is being used where possible and appropriate, but for dissemination, use of English is mandatory.

Matter regarding CGPA conversion formula, the members of the Council deliberated on the matter and finally decided to constitute a Committee for going through pros & cons and to arrive at the conclusion.

3. Discussion on conversion and reconversion of teaching posts Note from the Dean, Faculty of Science as stated below and approved in the Faculty meeting held on 7/11/2019:

# "Instructions and procedure for the conversion-reconversion of the posts

It is felt that a procedural guideline is necessary for the conversion and reconversion of teaching posts under pressing circumstance. The Academic Council has already approved the conversion of a post of higher grade to a post of lower grade in the departments of Gauhati University, if no suitable candidate is found. However, there is no detailed instruction/procedure to this effect. Hence the following rules are suggested for approval by Academic Council.

## Rule of Conversion

Rule 1. If after advertisement for two time for filling up of a post of Professor in a subject no candidate applies or no candidate is found suitable, the concerned department after approval in the DAC, may convert this post to post of Associate or Assistant Professor as the situation demands at that time and arrange for advertisement for a post of Associate Professor or Assistant Professor in lieu of a post of Professor by keeping the post of Professor in abeyance/suspension.

Rule 2. It after advertisement for two times for filling up of a post of Associate Professor in a subject no candidate applied or no candidate is found suitable, the department after approval in the DAC may convert this post to a post of Assistant Professor as the situation demands at that time and arrange for advertisement for a post of Assistant Professor in lieu of a post of Associate Professor by keeping the post of Associate Professor in abeyance/suspension.

#### Rules of Reconversion

Rule 3. If at any point of time the concerned DAC decides to apply for the reconversion to the post in higher grade kept in abeyance. It is possible when.

- A post of Professor was converted to a post of Associate Professor, then there
  must be a vacant position of Associate Professor in the department at the time
  of reconversion.
- ii) A post of Professor was converted to a post of Assistant Professor, then there must be a vacant position of Assistant Professor in the department at the time of reconversion.
- iii) A post of Associate Professor was converted to a post of Assistant Professor, then there must be a vacant position of Assistant Professor in the department at the time of reconversion."

The Vice-Chancellor opined that conversion of teaching post, and that too the posts of Professor is serious matter. He said that decision should not be taken hurriedly, otherwise the status of a department may suffer.

The House agreed to him.

The Council decided to defer the case for further examination of the Vice-Chancellor.
