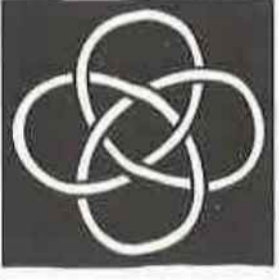

Born in 1985 in Guwahati, Dr. Hemen Kumar Kalita completed his Master's Degree in Physics from Gauhati University and joined the Nanomaterial Lab in IIT Bombay for his doctoral research with very high All India Rank. He has already published eleven research papers in very high impact factor journals and eleven more in reputed journals. His innovative work yielded six patent filings in four years, which itself is a commendable performance. With his hard work he has been able to set up a "State-of-the-art laboratory on Nanomaterial and Nano-electricity" at Gauhati University.

In recognition to Dr. Kalita's work, DST-SERB awarded him the Early Career Research Award in 2018. He also received UGC-BSR Start-up grant in 2018 itself. He also received ITGA grant from ASTEC in 2017. Dr. Kalita has already received invitations for Post-Doctoral work in very reputed Universities like Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Boston (USA), Michigan State University (USA) and Northwestern University, Evanston (USA).





Description

Citation metrics are widely used and misused. We have created a publicly available database of over 100,000 top-scientists that provides standardized information on citations, h-index, co-authorship-adjusted hm-index, citations to papers in different authorship positions and a composite indicator. Separate data are shown for career-long and single year impact. Metrics with and without self-citations and ratio of citations to citing papers are given. Scientists are classified into 22 scientific fields and 176 sub-fields. Field- and subfield-specific percentiles are also provided for all scientists who have published at least 5 papers. Career-long data are updated to end-of-2020. The selection is based on the top 100,000 by c-score (with and without self-citations) or a percentile rank of 2% or above.



We are glad to inform you that you have been selected for deputation as Visiting Professor of History Chair at the Mohammed V University, Rabat, Morocco for a period of two academic years, commencing from December, 2018 onwards. The terms and conditions of your deputation would be as follows:-

a. Immediately on finalization of your deputation, you should establish contact with the Embassy and you should invariably meet the HOM before joining/ starting the classes and get full briefing on the bilateral relations and local sensitivities from the HOM/ DCM.

b. Tenure: -

The period of deputation will commence from the date you join the University and ends on the day you are relieved from the University. You are entitled to preparation/joining time of up to 7 days at the time of commencement and completion of tenure, during which you should report to ICCR to sign your joining report/relieving report. If there is any gap between the dates of signing the joining report/relieving report and joining your Parent Office, it should be regularized by the latter under applicable rules.

c. Obligations:-

(i) You will discuss and finalize the curriculum in consultation with the Mohammed V University and share the details after finalization with ICCR.

(ii) You will teach the finalized curriculum/course in consultation with the University and will take part in other activities of the Institute such as departmental Seminars, Conferences, Faculty Meetings etc.

(iii) You will deliver a minimum of two public lectures in an academic year during your deputation to be arranged by the University / Indian Mission, which would be termed as "ICCR Lecture on India."

(iv) You would work harmoniously in coordination with the Indian Mission in arranging talks on India, workshops on Indian current academic/social interest etc. or any other assignment related to academics as decided by the host University in consultation with the Indian Mission.

(v) Conduct and performance: - You will abide by the host university's code of conduct and human resources policies and laws of the country during your deputation.

(vi) Employment of Spouse:- The spouse of yours, if residing with you, shall not accept any employment in Morocco, on payment basis without prior permission of the ICCR, who will consider such proposals only if recommended by the concerned Mission/Post and in consultation with the Ministry of External Affairs, when necessary. **(Note- All expenditure on accompanying spouse shall exclusively be borne by you).**

(vii) You will not be accompanied by your family unless duly permitted in terms of the MoU.

(viii) You will not claim any medical reimbursement in respect of your family.

e. Pay & other remuneration payable by ICCR :-

(vi) During the period of deputation, you will draw from the relevant Mission/Post the same basic pay and grade pay as is being drawn by you in the present scale of pay in parent organization, with annual increments to the next higher stages in the scale.

(vii) No other allowance, including deputation duty allowance, will be admissible.

(viii) The Quantum of Additional Allowance (foreign allowance) admissible will be determined on the basis of the country of deputation. The Quantum of Additional Allowance (foreign allowance) once fixed, will remain unchanged for the entire duration of the deputation and will not be affected by any revision of pay scales/grade pay on account of annual increment, promotion or grant of ACPs or any other factors.

(ix) Further, the Quantum of Additional Allowance (foreign allowance) will stand reduced to the extent of any honorarium being paid by the University/Institute under the MoU with ICCR. The Pay and other admissible allowances and their drawal during leave will be regulated in terms of relevant provisions of IFS (PLCA) Rules.

(x) You will not accept any other remuneration other than as provided in this letter.

Instructions for the Summer Research Fellows (SRFs):

A. Acceptance of Fellowship

1. The selection letter has been sent by email (along with instruction sheet). A hard copy of the letter has also been sent by speed post (along with instruction sheet, form for conveying acceptance, and form for sending joining report).
2. At the bottom of the email, an user-id and password are also provided for each SRF which will enable them to view their online page in our website and to fill in the required details. Make sure to save user-id and password, it will **not be** provided a second time.
3. Your acceptance to take up this fellowship should be conveyed **URGENTLY** within 7 days by filling in your online page (the user-id and password provided). The Form of Acceptance to be sent by speed post should also be returned to us **by speed post or courier** within 3 days after it reaches you.
4. **Do not wait for the approval from guide to send your Acceptance form.**
5. For some reason, if you do not wish to take up the fellowship, this should be conveyed to us **URGENTLY** by (a) filling in your online page, (b) email (fastsf@ias.ac.in), and also to your guide as well as (c) returning the Acceptance Form **all within one week of your receiving the letter of selection** so that the fellowship can be awarded without delay to another person in the waiting list.
6. After sending the acceptance, please contact your guide to fix up the exact date of joining. This exact date should then be communicated to us by email/online.
7. Two copies of your stamp-size photograph should be enclosed, of which one copy to be affixed to the letter of acceptance.

B. General Instructions

14. Communications (preferably in English) should be clear, concise and convey the intended meaning.
15. **SRFs must strictly follow the rules and regulations** (oral and written) stipulated by the host institution, both in the working laboratory and at the place of their stay. If any malpractices on the part of the SRF are reported, the Academy will be constrained to terminate the fellowship.

C. Progress Reports

16. Your 4-week report must be written and submitted to your guide using the link sent to you by (**www.authorcafe.com**). The approval of the 4-week report will also generate the link for you to write your 8-week report. You should follow the same process as for the 4-week report to write and submit your 8-week report to your guide for approval, using the link sent to you by (**www.authorcafe.com**). 16a. 




