The club conducts regular meetings with a formalized structure in place. The President, along with students and faculty members, are appointed by Vice Chancellor Prof. Pratap Jyoti Handique, following consultations with the Registrar and the Deans of various faculties of Gauhati University.

Introduction

Vision

Functions
