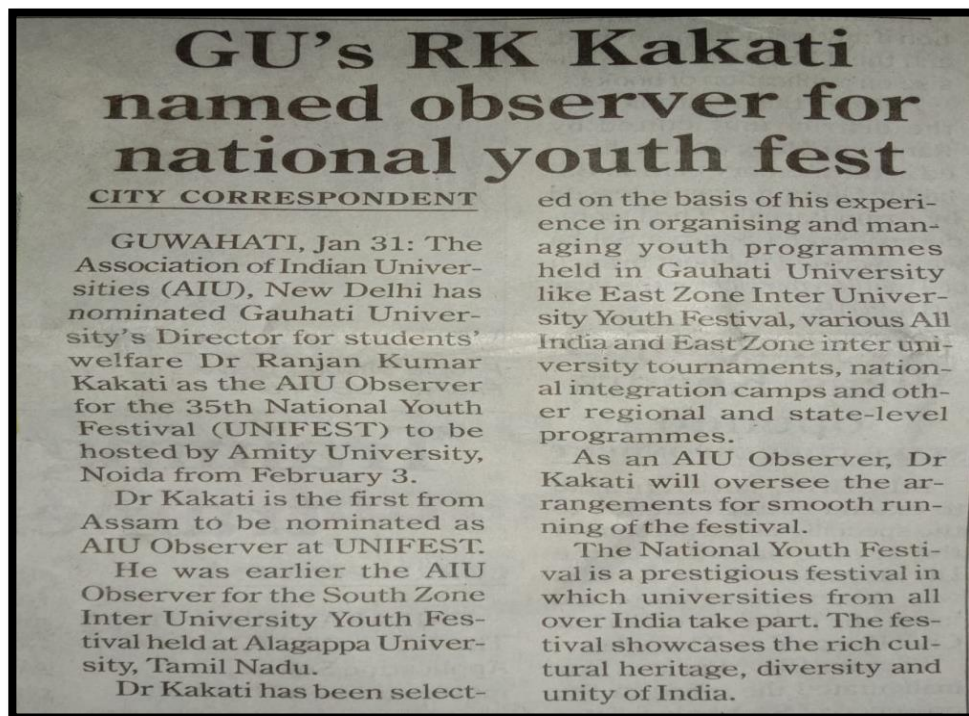

### NSS ACTIVITIES

- ❖ **PLANTATION DURING 2020-2021** :- Every NSS Unit conducts plantation drive in their institutional campus as well as at Adopted villages. 210 Plantation drives were organized by all the NSS Units during which 50000 saplings were planted in the college campus, adopted villages, local schools and public places. Instructions were given to all the Units for selection of saplings, conduct survey before plantation, care for every saplings by each volunteers for two years. Follow up action to be taken accordingly by all NSS Units and Programme Coordinator, GU NSS Cell.

- ❖ **BLOOD DONATION CAMP DURING 2020-2021** :-Among all the NSS units during the session 2020-2021 volunteers donated around 1500 units during the year. Also, as and when necessary volunteers were informed through WhatsApp group message to donate Blood in local hospitals to needy peoples.
  
- ❖ **DURING 2020-2021** 1350 AIDS/ Health awareness programmes were organized by all the NSS units to raise awareness on different health related issues and to sensitise people of the adopted villages and nearby community of the institutions. Mental health supporting programmes were also organised during this COVID-19 pandemic situation.
  
- ❖ **ENVIRONMENT PROGRAMMES DURING 2020-2021**:-220 programmes on Environment awareness were organized by all the NSS Units to raise awareness on protecting the environment and conservation of Biodiversity resources. NSS Volunteers and Programme Officers were trained about sustainable development goals (SDG) of United Nations and ask to follow up action plans accordingly in our concern areas.
  
- ❖ **DURING THE PERIOD 2020- 2021**:-156 awareness programmes on Youth& career development, sports, Drugs Abuse Prevention, women empowerment, National Unity, Disaster management, women trafficking, Science day, leadership and personality development, Life skill etc were organized by all the NSS Units
  
- ❖ **CLEANLINESS DRIVES DURING 2020- 2021**: -350 Cleanliness drives were organized under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan in colleges, adopted villages, schools, public offices and places by all the NSS units. Summer Internship Programme and Swachhata Pakhwada were also organised as per action plan of Ministry of Youth Affairs, Govt. Of India and Directorate of NSS, New Delhi in all the NSS units. This year due to COVID-19 Pandemic, proper protocols were maintained for smooth completion of the cleanliness drives.

#### **SPREADING OF AWARENESS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND DISTRIBUTION OF FOOD AND ESSENTIAL ITEMS AND MASKS ETC.**

At the start of the year 2020 the world had to face a new viral COVID -19 disease which was declared as pandemic by World Health Organization. During the COVID- 19 lockdown period enforced by the government the NSS volunteers of GU NSS Cell realized that they had enormous responsibility to lend a helping hand to the local administration in creating awareness amongst the general public against the disease.

The Gauhati University NSS Cell devised a strategy and had assigned one Programme Officer each as District Nodal Officer (DNO) in all districts to help State NSS Officer & Programme Coordinator to fight against COVID-19 pandemic. All the DNO's had met the concerned District Administration to discuss about the utilization of the service of NSS to fight against COVID -19. COVID Warriors of the NSS units of all districts conducted various activities to create awareness and help people during COVID pandemic. Some of the achievements are mentioned below:

**A) MAKING OF VIDEO CLIPS ON COVID-19 AWARENESS:-**More than 100 video clips in Assamese, Hindi and English dialect on Corona virus awareness were prepared by NSS Volunteers from different NSS units under GU NSS Cell. The video clips covering the topics like importance of wearing face masks, washing hands frequently etc were uploaded in the social media platforms to help target the people residing in the rural areas. This was found to be very helpful for spreading awareness about Covid-19 among the public.

**B) TELEPHONIC CONSULTATION WITH THE PEOPLE WHO WERE QUARANTINED:-**NSS volunteers of some Colleges under GU NSS Cell made telephonic conversation with the quarantined people and consulted them to provide mental relief. Accordingly the quarantined people also expressed their gratitude towards the NSS volunteers.

**C) BLOOD DONATION:-**During this period, NSS volunteers and Programme Officers tied up with all the district blood banks and assured them to donate blood by the NSS Volunteers whenever there is a shortage. NSS volunteers had donated more than 1500 units of blood to different hospitals in their respective districts.

**D) PREPARING AND SUPPLYING FOOD ITEMS TO THE NEEDY PEOPLE:-**NSS Volunteers and PO's prepared food items and supplied them to the needy ones. Food and essential items including sanitary napkins, hand sanitizer etc were provided to around 2,00,000 needy people in their adopted villages and locality during the COVID period. Also many institution & colleges under GU NSS Cell have distributed food items to the attendants of COVID-19 patient in their tough time by the NSS Volunteers.

**E) MAKING AND DISTRIBUTION OF FACE MASKS TO THE LOCAL PEOPLE:-**

More than 50,000 face masks were prepared by the NSS Volunteers of different NSS units using the available household materials which were distributed to the local people, neighbours, vendors, traffic police etc. Also the NSS volunteers and PO's from many institutions distributed hand sanitizers and face masks to the homeless people.

**F) MAINTENANCE OF SOCIAL DISTANCING AT PUBLIC PLACES:-**In most of the districts, NSS volunteers aware people about maintaining social distancing at public places like hospitals, medical stores, vegetable shops, banks etc. NSS Unit of some Colleges organized a door to door COVID-19 and Vaccination Awareness Programme in their locality with the guidance of Programme Officers. During the awareness programme, volunteers visited different households of their adopted villages and interacted with individuals about the pandemic, importance of vaccination, sanitization, online registration process for vaccination etc.

Around 900 volunteers have been engaged in different vaccination centres from different colleges under GU NSS Cell.

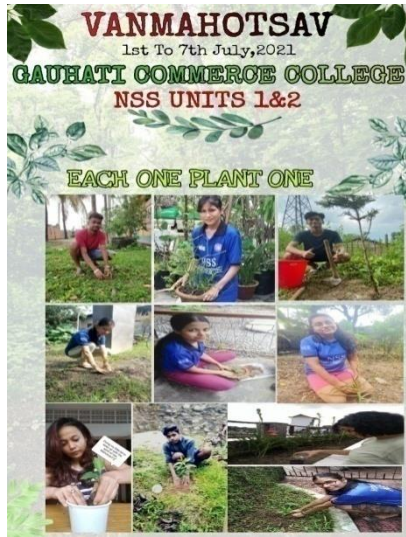

### World Zoonoses Day observed

GUWAHATI, July 6: "As a part of the 'one world, one health initiative', veterinarians should work with people at the local, national and international levels to curb the spread of zoonotic diseases," observed the additional director of the State Animal Husbandry and Veterinary department, Dr. Dilip Bhuyan while inaugurating a programme organised on the occasion of World Zoonoses Day here today.

The programme was organised by the Assam Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Service Association (AAHVSA) in association with its Kamrup (Merni) branch at the premises of the Chemkuthi veterinary hospital. This time, the theme of the day was 'Let's break the chain of zoonotic transmission.'

Addressing the event, Dr Bhuyan suggested that the day should be observed more widely in rural areas of the State with the participation of the farmers. The World Zoonoses Day is observed on July 6 every year to create awareness about zoonotic diseases. It may be mentioned that it was on this day way back in 1986 that the Rabies vaccine was administered for the first time by the great scientist Louis Pasteur. Zoonoses is the spread of infectious diseases from animals to human beings. Notably, around 75 per cent of new and existing diseases, affecting human civilisation across the globe, have originated from animals, including African sleeping sickness, anthrax, bird flu, ebola, diarrhoea, influenza, leprosy, nipah virus infection, rabies, swine influenza or swine flu, etc.

The function was moderated by AAHVSA general secretary Dr Bhoban Chandra Sarma while AAHVSA president Dr Dandewar Deka delivered the welcome address.

On the same occasion, Just Be Friendly, an NGO working for animals, provided free anti-Rabies vaccination to cats and dogs simultaneously at 11 different locations across the State. The drive was conducted with the support of government authorities and private stakeholders at all the locations.

The Gauhati University also celebrated World Zoonoses Day today. As part of the celebration, a national webinar was organised by GU NSS Cell in association with Humane Society International, India.

Inaugurating the webinar Professor Sweta Saran, Dean, School of life Sciences, JNU, New Delhi said that zoonoses are infectious diseases caused by a pathogen that has jumped from an animal to a human like the present coronavirus disease.

Professor Saran said that since zoos are available when a new zoonotic disease spreads, prevention and awareness are the best ways to stop it from spreading.

Attending the webinar as chief guest, Professor Birinchi Kr Das, V.C, Bhattadev University said that the way society interacts with animals has serious implications for global human health. Professor Das urged all to take precautions while interacting with animals.

Dr Ranjan Kr Kakati, DSW and PC, GU NSS said, "The growing severity of Covid-19 is making us rethink ways to reduce transmission risk of emerging diseases from animals to humans." He urged everyone to keep a close watch on food habits.

Invited speakers Noyonika Gogoi and Swarnali Roy from Humane Society International, India spoke at length on human and animal health. The webinar was moderated by Dr Sumadhur Roy, NSS PO, Gauhati Commerce College. About 250 participants from across the country comprising faculties, NGO executives, NSS volunteers and programme officers attended the webinar.

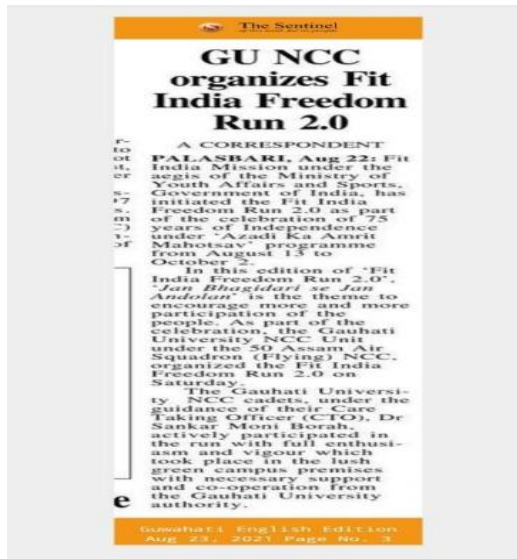

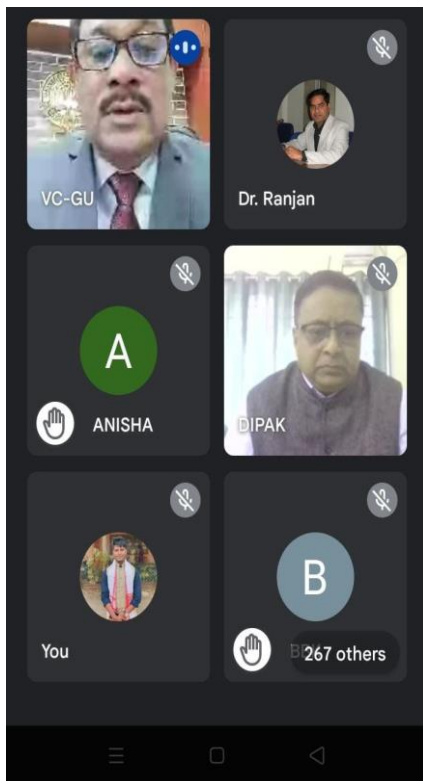
## ❖ GAUHATI UNIVERSITY CELEBRATED RIVERS OF INDIA PROGRAM AT PANDU GHAT
